RESOLUTION NO. 049 Series of 2020

(Re: Accreditation of Boldline Trading
as a GPS Device Provider)

WHEREAS, on 4 May 2015, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2015-013 re: Guidelines to Govern the Accreditation of GPS Device Providers wherein the guidelines governing the accreditation of Global Positioning System (GPS) Device Providers are promulgated and acceptance of applications for the issuance of a Certificate of Accreditation was opened;

WHEREAS, on 5 December 2016, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2016-016 re: *Amendment to Memorandum Circular No. 2015-024 (Re: Amendment to Memorandum Circular No. 2015-013) Reinstating and Revising the Accreditation Process under Memorandum Circular No. 2015-013 (Re: Guidelines to Govern the Accreditation of GPS Device Providers)*, wherein the Board reinstated and revised some of the provisions of Memorandum Circular No. 2015-013, particularly the Item Nos. II, III, VI and Bus GNSS Registration Process;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2015-013, a Pre-Accreditation Committee was created to evaluate all applications for the issuance of Certificate of Accreditation as a GPS Device Provider which filed before the LTFRB and recommend to the Board its approval and disapproval;

WHEREAS, on 24 June 2019, the applicant Boldline Trading filed its documents required under Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 (Sections II, III and IV) and 2016-016 to apply for the issuance of a Certificate of Accreditation wherein an evaluation was conducted by the Committee and a recommendation was made on 27 November 2019;


WHEREAS, after careful and thorough evaluation of the above application and its supporting documents, the Pre-Accreditation Committee finds that the herein applicant failed to submit/provide the following requirements, to wit:

1. List of all clients (with contact person, address and telephone/mobile numbers) in the transportation industry;
2. 24/7 Nationwide Technical Support;
3. Warranty of the GPS Device, which shall not be less than one (1) year from installation;
4. Proposed Procedure for Repair and Replacement of Defective GPS Device;
5. Undertaking of the applicant to comply with the provisions of PNS ISO/IEC 17025;

6. Company policy and procedure for resolution of complaints from the operators;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, finding the documents submitted by Boldline Trading on 24 June 2019 to be incomplete due to its failure to submit/provide the above-mentioned documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 and 2016-016, this Committee resolves to **DIRECT** the herein applicant to **SUBMIT** to the Pre-Accreditation Committee of the same within the fifteen (15) working days from receipt of this resolution.
