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**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 062  
SERIES OF 2020**

**WHEREAS**, in December 2019, the World Health Organization (WHO) was alerted of several respiratory cases which were later on attributed to what is now known as the “Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)”;

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Proclamation No. 922 entitled “*Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency Throughout the Philippines*” on 08 March 2020;

**WHEREAS**, on 12 March 2020, the Inter Agency Task Force (IATF) of Infectious Disease recommended to the President a Community Quarantine in the National Capital Region (NCR), which formed part of the Proclamation by the President to restrict entry to and from Metro Manila, and subsequently, the IATF also restricted mobility in the Visayas and Mindanao;

**WHEREAS**, on 23 March 2020, the Board issued a directive nationwide regarding the *Guidelines for Waiver of Penalties in View of the Limited Office Operation as a Preventive Measure to Avoid the Spread of the COVID-19*;

**WHEREAS**, on 24 April 2020, the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) remain to be enforced in several parts of the country until May 15, 2020, and shall be subject to further review by the IATF;

**WHEREAS**, in relation to the aforementioned proclamation which would inevitably delay LTFRB's usual processes, the Board, in the exercise of its power and functions to “promulgate rules and regulations governing proceedings before the Board and the Regional Franchising and Regulatory Offices; as provided under Section 5(i) of Executive Order No. 202, deems it appropriate to amend its rules and regulations;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing national emergency, the Board hereby sets and adopts the following guidelines:

a. On Confirmation of Units:

1. All PUVs with Plate Numbers ending in 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be allowed to confirm their units until 31 July 2020 with **waiver of penalties**.

*In this regard, the corresponding insurance policies under the Personal Passenger Accident Insurance Program (PPAIP) of PUV units covered under this item shall be automatically extended until 31 July 2020 without additional fees on the part of the operators. Within the period given, operators are required to secure renewal or updated insurance policies as part of the confirmation of their units.*

b. On Filing of Extension of Validity for CPCs

1. Applications for Extension of Validity for Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) with expiry dates from 17 March 2020 to 15 May 2020 can be filed until 31 July 2020 with **waiver of penalties**.

All applications for Extension of Validity for CPC shall include an Undertaking to Consolidate under the PUV Modernization Program (PUVMP) by 31 December 2020.

c. On Issuance of Provisional Authorities and Special Permits

1. All Provisional Authorities and Special Permits (SP) issued with expiry dates covering the period of 17 March 2020 to 15 May 2020, shall be extended until 31 July 2020 with **waiver of fees**.

Within the given period, all TNVS operators are required to process their applications accordingly. No extension of PA shall be allowed beyond 31 July 2020.

d. On Compliance Orders, Resolution, and Decisions directing operators to comply within a given period


1. Compliance Orders, Resolutions, and Decisions which direct operators to comply within a certain period and which period falls between 17 March 2020 until 15 May 2020, shall be allowed to comply until 31 July 2020 with waiver of penalties, if any.


