**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 100**  
**SERIES OF 2020**

**WHEREAS**, on 29 April 2020, the Board issued Board Resolution No. 62 which provided the guidelines extending the period of filing and waiver of penalties for select transactions;

**WHEREAS**, on 11 May 2020, the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) has issued Resolution No. 35 which has placed several areas under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) and other areas remain under Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ), which classification shall remain until 31 May 2020;

**WHEREAS**, most of the Regional Franchising and Regulatory Offices (RFROs) as well as the Central Office, are still operating under limited personnel which continues to affect LTFRB's usual processes;

**WHEREAS**, the Board, in the exercise of its power and functions to “promulgate rules and regulations governing proceedings before the Board and the Regional Franchising and Regulatory Offices; as provided under Section 5(i) of Executive Order No. 202”, deems it appropriate to amend its rules and regulations;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing national emergency, the Board hereby AMENDS Board Resolution No. 62, Series of 2020 as follows :

b. On Filing of Extension of Validity for CPCs

1. Applications for Extension of Validity (EOV) for Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) with expiry dates from 17 March 2020 to 15 May 2020 can be filed until 31 July 2020 with waiver of penalties. The corresponding Decision to be issued for Extension of Validity of CPC shall be until 31 December 2020.

**For CPC with expiry from 16 May 2020 to 30 June 2020, operators can file their applications for EOV until 31 August 2020 with waiver of penalties. The corresponding Decision to be issued for Extension of Validity of CPC shall be until 31 December 2020.**

All applications for Extension of Validity for CPC shall include an Undertaking to Consolidate under the PUV Modernization Program (PUVMP) not later 31 December 2020.

c. On Issuance of Provisional Authorities and Special Permits

1. All Provisional Authorities and Special Permits (SP) issued with expiry dates covering the period of 17 March 2020 to 15 May 2020, shall be extended until 31 July 2020 with waiver of fees.

**All Provisional Authorities issued with expiry dates covering the period of 16May 2020 to 30 June 2020 shall be extended until 31 July 2020 with waiver of fees. All Special Permits (SP) issued under the PUVMP and P2P Routes with expiry dates covering the period of 16May 2020 to 30 June 2020 shall be extended until 31 July 2020 with waiver of fees.**

Within the given period, all TNVS operators are required to process their applications accordingly, failure of which shall cause the dismissal of their applications.

- d. On Compliance Orders, Resolution, and Decisions directing operators to comply within a given period
1. Compliance Orders, Resolutions, and Decisions which direct operators to comply within a certain period and which period falls between 17 March 2020 until 15 May 2020, shall be allowed to comply until 31 July 2020 with waiver of penalties, if any.

**Compliance Orders, Resolutions, and Decisions which direct operators to comply within a certain period and which period falls between 16 May 2020 until 30 June 2020, shall be allowed to comply until 31 August 2020 with waiver of penalties, if any.**
