RESOLUTION NO. 120 Series of 2020

(Re: Application of MKZ TRANSPORT - OPC for the opening of additional Taxi Franchise for Metro Manila including MUCEP Area under Memorandum Circular Nos. 2018-026 and 2019-051)

WHEREAS, on 19 December 2018, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2018-026 also known as the "Opening of Additional Taxi Franchise for Metro Manila including MUCEP Area" to hereby OPEN additional air-conditioned taxi franchise for five thousand (5,000) units for Metro Manila including the MUCEP area;

WHEREAS, on 23 September 2019, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-051 also known as the "Amendment to Memorandum Circular No. 2018-026 (Reduction in the Minimum Number of Units per Application)" to REDUCE the minimum number of units per application to twenty-five (25) units and that the maximum remains at one thousand (1,000) units;

WHEREAS, on 17 January 2020, MKZ TRANSPORT - OPC filed its application for the opening of additional taxi franchise for Metro Manila including MUCEP area under Memorandum Circular No. 2018-026 with the use of twenty-five (25) taxi units and that the selection proceedings were thereafter conducted on 4 March 2020;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that MKZ TRANSPORT - OPC has submitted a copy of the Pro-Forma Invoice from Toyota Otis, Inc. dated 26 December 2019 numbered 2019-00878 in favor of MKZ TRANSPORT - OPC relating to the purchase of twenty-five (25) units 2020 Toyota Vios 1.3 MT Base amounting to two million seven hundred forty thousand pesos (Php 2,740,000.00) which the said copy is certified correct and payment not yet received;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that MKZ TRANSPORT - OPC has submitted an (1) original copy of the Bank Deposit Certification from UCPB Anonas Branch dated 27 December 2019 numbered BDC-170-2019-0173 which certifies that MKZ TRANSPORT - OPC maintains a peso Checking Account with cleared balance amounting to two million one thousand pesos (Php 2,001,000.00) as of 26 December 2019, (2) copy of Account History Inquiry from UCPB Anonas Branch with CIF Number M170330 described as CA BULK CHQ W/O DET dated 12/12/19 which states that credit amount and ledger balance are with the same amount of five hundred thousand (500,000.00); (3) copy of Account Summary for the period May 07, 2019 - Aug 07, 2019 from BPI Kamias - Anonas branch numbered 3329-1130-69 under the name of Ramon Michael V Guico stating that the same has an ending balance of 827,043.60; the sum of all the financial documents submitted above is amounting to three million three hundred twenty-eight thousand forty-three pesos and six centavos (Php 3,328,043.6);

WHEREAS, the Committee found that MKZ TRANSPORT - OPC failed to include/submit in its qualification documents the following requirements:

1. Original or certified true copies of By-Laws;

2. Latest General Information Sheet duly received/issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission;
3. OR/CR of the proposed units or Sales Invoice and Delivery Receipt;
4. Supporting documentation to show that the proposed units are equipped/capable of GNSS receiver, free Wi-Fi access, CCTV with continuous recording of past hours of operation, dashboard camera (at least 24 hours of recording), compliant with Euro 4 emission standards or better;
5. Documents to provide that the applicant has available financial resources equivalent to or exceeding the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand Pesos (P 800,000.00) multiplied by the total number of vehicles that the applicant is applying for;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to DIRECT the applicant MKZ TRANSPORT - OPC to SUBMIT within fifteen working (15) days from receipt of this resolution the above-mentioned documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2018-026. Failure to comply within the prescribed period shall cause the dismissal of the application.
