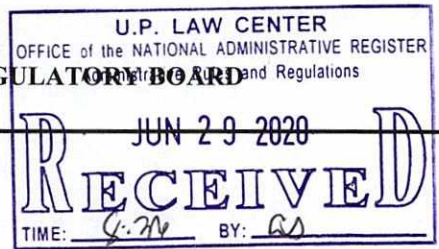

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
 NO. 2020-023-A**

**SUBJECT : SUPPLEMENTAL TO THE GUIDELINES FOR THE
 OPERATIONS OF OFG-COMPLIANT PUJ VEHICLES
 DURING THE PERIOD OF GCQ IN METRO MANILA**

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-023 on the resumption of operations for OFG-compliant PUJ units starting 22 June 2020 during the period of General Community Quarantine (GCQ) in Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, under Annex "A" of said Circular, several routes have been included for OFG-compliant units to ply their original routes (original route structure prior to the declaration of Enhanced Community Quarantine last 17 March 2020);

WHEREAS, after an evaluation of the other routes, and consistent with the directive of the Board to review existing routes, there are several PUJ routes being served by OFG-compliant units that are likewise to be retained;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the following original routes are deemed included and to supplement to Annex "A" of Memorandum Circular No. 2020-023:

ROUTE	No. of Authorized Units
Cubao – Sta. Lucia, Pasig	30
Rosario Jct. – San Juan via Pinaglabanan	31

In this regard, existing OFG-compliant operators plying the abovementioned routes shall be allowed to resume their operations immediately, without the need for a Special Permit. Said operators shall comply with the health and operational requirements required by the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) and Department of Transportation (DOTr) Guidelines on Public Transport under GCQ.

All other provisions of MC 2020-023 are deemed incorporated herein.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation. Let three (3) copies hereof be filed with the UP Law Center – Office of National Administrative Registrar (ONAR).
