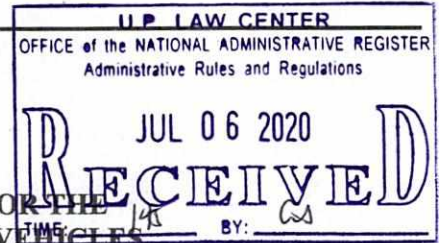

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 2020-023-B

SUBJECT : SUPPLEMENTAL TO THE GUIDELINES FOR THE OPERATIONS OF OFG-COMPLIANT PUJ VEHICLES DURING THE PERIOD OF GCQ IN METRO MANILA

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-023 on the resumption of operations for OFG-compliant PUJ units starting 22 June 2020 during the period of General Community Quarantine (GCQ) in Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, under Annex "B" of said Circular, several routes have been included for OFG-compliant units to ply their routes (route structures have been modified while maintaining their existing origin and destination or those routes that have been amended/rationalized);

WHEREAS, after an evaluation of the other routes, and consistent with the directive of the Board to review existing routes, there are several PUJ routes being served by OFG-compliant units that are likewise to operate upon modification of their route structure.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the following route is deemed included and to supplement to Annex "B" of Memorandum Circular No. 2020-023:

Rodriguez - BFCT	15	J.P. Rizal – Millex Rd. – DaangBakal St. – GSIS Rd. – E. delos Santos Rd. – Gen. Luna Ave. – Spanish St. – Dahlia St. – Jasper – Juan Luna – C.M. Recto St. – Paraluman St. – A. de Guzman St. – Molave St. – C. Bautista St. – E. Rodriguez Ave. – Aquilina St. – Mayor G. Fernando Ave. – Marcos Highway – BFCT East Terminal

In this regard, existing OFG-compliant operators plying the abovementioned routes shall secure a SPECIAL PERMIT prior to their operations, and shall comply with the health and operational requirements required by the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) and Department of Transportation (DOTr) Guidelines on Public Transport under GCQ.

All other provisions of MC 2020-023 are deemed incorporated herein.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation. Let three (3) copies hereof be filed with the UP Law Center – Office of National Administrative Registrar (ONAR).


