BOARD RESOLUTION NO. _____ 126
SERIES OF 2020

WHEREAS, on 14 May 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-019 which set forth the Guidelines for the Operations of PUB in Metro Manila for the period of General Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, as part of said Guidelines is the identification of bus routes, including Route No. 2 from Monument to PITX;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Circular, the selected bus consortium to operate Route No. 2 was given to Mega Manila Consortium for which the corresponding Special Permit was issued for the use of ninety-six (96) bus units;

WHEREAS, in line with the Board's monitoring of public land transport during the period of General Community Quarantine (GCQ), it appears that passenger demand for the route of PITX-Lawton has been increasing, and the Board deems it necessary to augment the units provided by the existing operator for modern PUJs;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and following the hierarchy of public transport service, the Board hereby RESOLVES as it is hereby RESOLVED to :

1. Augment the existing modern PUJs plying the route PITX – Lawton with buses which are servicing Route No. 2 in order to meet the increased passenger demand in PITX-Lawton route;
2. Authorize the issuance of Special Permit to Mega Manila Consortium for the use of thirty (30) units [from its existing ninety-six (96) units under Route 2] to ferry passengers from PITX to Lawton on the route: **PITX-Lawton via Roxas Blvd, Padre Burgos Avenue**. Accordingly, the Technical Division is hereby directed to prepare and issue said Special Permits to Mega Manila Consortium.
3. The Special Permit to be issued herein shall be only for the duration of the GCQ and MGCQ unless terminated/revoked earlier by the Board.
