BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 127 Series of 2020

WHEREAS, in December 2019, the World Health Organization (WHO) was alerted of several respiratory cases which were later on attributed to what is known as the "Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19)";

WHEREAS, on 8 March 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed a Proclamation No. 922, placing the entire country under State of Public Health Emergency, where the Inter Agency Task Force (IATF) of Infectious Disease subsequently recommended to the President a Community Quarantine in the National Capital Region (NCR), followed by restricted mobility in the Visayas and Mindanao;

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the implementation of Community Quarantine throughout the country, private and public offices were closed primarily to ensure the safety of the public and prevent the spread of the virus;

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the depressing effect of the pandemic, the Board, in ensuring continuous and unhampered delivery of land transportation services to the public, passed corresponding issuances, extending the validity of authority, compliance to Orders and Decisions, and the filing of applications, petitions and other transactions, which expired or about to expire during the Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, perused from the records of this office, the Certificate of Accreditation of several Transportation Network Companies (TNCs) have already expired or about to expire during the Community Quarantine period:

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing circumstances, with the end view of providing continuous delivery of transportation services to the public, the Board resolves as it hereby resolved to **EXTEND** the authority of those existing TNCs whose Certificate of Accreditation have expired or about to expire during the Community Quarantine period, as well as the **FILING** of Application for Renewal of Accreditation, to an unextendable period of until **31 July 2020**. Failure to file an Application for Renewal of Certificate of Accreditation on the said date shall automatically revoke the authority of the TNC to accredit TNVS and operate as Transport Network Company.

All other terms and conditions relative to their original accreditation shall remain in full force and effect for the duration of the extended period.
