RESOLUTION NO. 140 Series of 2020

(Re: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New CPC for the route:
TANGUB CITY, MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL - MOLAVE, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR)

WHEREAS, before this Committee are the applications of STA. MARIA TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE and I-SHALOM CORPORATION for Tangub City, Misamis Occidental - Molave, Zamboanga Del Sur route with the use of fifteen (15) authorized Class 3 UV units, under the initial selection/qualification process conducted on 16 October 2019;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that STA. MARIA TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE failed to submit/include in its qualification documents the original copy of Certificate of Registration and Certificate of Accreditation issued by the Office of the Transportation Cooperative (OTC), no photocopy of undertaking to comply with the OFG and DTI-PNS specifications standards, no undertaking to comply with the approved rationalization study, and no vehicle dispatch procedures for the route applied for;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that I-SHALOM CORPORATION failed to submit/include in its qualification documents copies of letter of support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in the route map, and no proposed garage/depot space pursuant to MC No. 2017-027;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to:

1. **DENY** the application of STA. MARIA TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE and I-SHALOM CORPORATION for failure to comply with the documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013. This is however without prejudice on their part to re-apply or submit application once the route is subsequently re-opened;

2. **DECLARE FAILURE** of the initial qualification process of the subject route;
3. **RE-OPEN** the route TANGUB CITY, MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL - MOLAVE, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR to prospective applicants and be given ten (10) working days reckoned from the date hereof to file their Letter of Intent and qualification documents.
