**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 161**  
**SERIES OF 2020**

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Proclamation No. 922 entitled “*Declaring A State Of Public Health Emergency Throughout the Philippines*” on 8 March 2020, upon confirmation of local transmission of COVID-19 in the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, in view of the increased number of confirmed COVID-19 cases, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Proclamation No. 929 entitled “*Declaring A State of Calamity Throughout the Philippines Due to Corona Virus Disease 2019*” on 16 March 2020;

**WHEREAS**, on May 27, 2020, Resolution No. 40 was issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases, and which was adopted and approved by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte;

**WHEREAS**, in the said Resolution, the National Capital Region was placed under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) wherein public transportation shall be allowed to operate at a reduced operational and vehicle capacity in accordance with the guidelines issued by the DOTr;

**WHEREAS**, in view of the reclassification of NCR to GCQ status, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-023C and pursuant thereto, the following routes were allowed to operate : (a) Alabang – Buencamino, Muntinlupa; (b) Alabang – Tunasan, Muntinlupa; and (c) Bamboo Organ, Las Pinas – SM Southmall;

**WHEREAS**, Great Power Movers Transportation Corp., was issued Special Permit to run the route Bamboo Organ, Las Pinas – SM Southmall with the use of thirty-three (33) modern PUJ units. However, upon confirmation only thirty (30) are actually running the route as three (3) units have been contracted as shuttle service for the Research Institute for Topical Medicine (RITM) in Muntinlupa and with Special Permit issued for this purpose;

**WHEREAS**, in a letter dated 24 August 2020, Great Power Movers Transportation Corp. reported that it encountered difficulty in running the route Bamboo Organ, Las Pinas – SM Southmall due to the opposition of local tricycle operators in the area of operation and has requested that its units be transferred to the routes: (a) Alabang – Buencamino, Muntinlupa; and (b) Alabang – Tunasan, Muntinlupa;

**WHEREAS**, on 26 August 2020, the LTFRB-NCR had a virtual meeting with the City of Muntinlupa through the Muntinlupa Traffic Management Bureau to discuss routes within Muntinlupa City that needs to be served and in said meeting, the routes: (a) Alabang – Buencamino, Muntinlupa and (b) Alabang – Tunasan, Muntinlupa have been confirmed as among the needed routes for its constituents;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board hereby **RESOLVES** as follows:

1. **APPROVE** the request of **GREAT POWER MOVERS TRANSPORTATION, INC.** to transfer its units from the route Bamboo Organ, Las Pinas – SM Southmall to: (a) Alabang – Buencamino, Muntinlupa and (b) Alabang – Tunasan, Muntinlupa with the use of fifteen (15) modern PUJ units for each route;
2. **DIRECT** LTFRB-NCR to issue the necessary Special Permit to implement the foregoing and pursuant to provisions of Memorandum Circular No. 2020-023.
