RESOLUTION NO. 167 Series of 2020

(Re: General Community Quarantine (GCQ) SPECIAL PERMIT for the Route No. 35: Ayala to Balibago via SLEX, under Memorandum Circular No. 2020-038)

WHEREAS, before this Committee is the application of **MEGA MANILA CONSORTIUM CORPORATION** whose participating member-operators are listed in Annex "A" and **J & A CHUA MANAGEMENT GROUP** whose participating member-operators are listed in Annex "B" for the Issuance of GCQ Special Permit for the Route No. 35: Ayala to Balibago via SLEX with the use of seventy-four (74) authorized PUB units;

WHEREAS, after due evaluation, the Committee found that the group of **MEGA MANILA CONSORTIUM CORPORATION** has applied for seventy four (74) units, while **J & A CHUA MANAGEMENT GROUP** has applied for fifty nine (59) units;

WHEREAS, further evaluation revealed that all the units proposed by **MEGA MANILA CONSORTIUM CORP.** from its participating members are all area-based operators, while the units proposed by **J & A CHUA MANAGEMENT GROUP** came from CPCs of its participating members which are not area-based;

WHEREAS, evaluation further revealed that out of the seventy four (74) units proposed by **MEGA MANILA CONSORTIUM CORP.**, thirty (30) units were already issued a Special Permit to operate in another route;

WHEREAS, applicant **MEGA MANILA CONSORTIUM CORPORATION** has substantially complied with the General, Legal and Technical Requirements as required under Memorandum Circular No. 2020-038, in relation to Memorandum Circular No. 2020-019;

WHEREAS, there exist an exigency of service to provide sufficient number of public utility vehicle with due regard to the interest of the commuting public during the GCQ period;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to **RECOMMEND** to the Board to:

1. **GRANT** the issuance of GCQ Special Permit to **MEGA MANILA CONSORTIUM CORP** for the initial Forty Four (44) PUBs units to ply along Route No. 35: Ayala to Balibago via SLEX,
2. Additionally, **MEGA MANILA CONSORTIUM CORP** shall complete the remaining Thirty (30) PUB units to ply the Route No. 35: Ayala to Balibago via SLEX, to be sourced from other existing qualified area-based operators.
