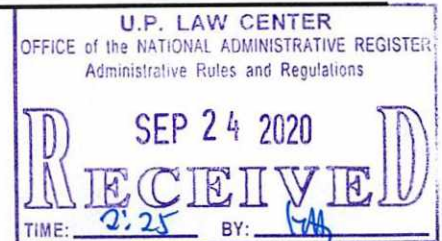

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT : RECTIFICATION OF MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2020-023-C

WHEREAS, on 24 July 2020, this Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-023-C Re: Additional Routes Allowed for the Operation of OFG-Compliant PUJ Vehicles During the Period of GCQ in Metro Manila or Entering Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, one of the routes opened under item no. 8 of the MC is the route: CARISSA HOMES, SJDM, BULACAN-NOVALICHES, QUEZON CITY PROPER, VIA CAMARIN ROAD AAND VICE VERSA;

WHEREAS, in a subsequent issuance or in Memorandum Circular No. 2020-037 dated August 14, 2020, additional PUJ routes were again opened and included therein is Route No. T128 or PALMERA, SAN JOSE DEL MONTE, BULACAN – NOVALICHES, QUEZON CITY, which is found to be redundant with the route first opened in MC No. 2020-023-C;

WHEREAS, Carissa Homes is within Palmera, hence, potential passengers from Carissa Homes can be served by Palmera route;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board being in the process of rationalizing all routes to avoid overlapping and crisscrossing of routes, the Board **RESOLVES** as it hereby **RESOLVED** to remove/delete the route CARISSA HOMES, SJDM, BULACAN-NOVALICHES, QUEZON CITY PROPER, VIA CAMARIN ROAD AND VICE VERSA under item no. 8 of MC 2020-023-C to **RETAIN** Route No. T128 or PALMERA, SAN JOSE DEL MONTE, BULACAN – NOVALICHES, QUEZON CITY under MC NO. 2020-037.

All issuance inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded and amended accordingly.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation. Let three (3) copies hereof be filed with the UP Law Center-Office of the National Administrative Registrar (ONAR).



WHEREAS, Carissa Homes is within Palmira, hence, potential passengers from Carissa Homes can be served by Palmira route;


