BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 213 Series of 2020
(Re: PM JEEPNEY DRIVERS & OPERATORS WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATIONS AND ENDORSEMENT TO ITS MEMBERS COOPERATIVE OR CORPORATION)

WHEREAS, PM Jeepney Drivers and Operators Service, Inc., (PM Jeepney) has filed Applications for Issuance of Certificates of Public Convenience at LTFRB Regional Office III docketed under Case Nos. RFRO-III-201800524, RFRO-III-201800521, RFRO-III-201800520, RFRO-III-201800522, RFRO-III-201800523, RFRO-III-201800525, and RFRO-III-201800526;

WHEREAS, Motions to Withdraw Applications and Endorse Routes to different entities were filed by PM Jeepney in the above case numbers at LTFRB Regional Office III, which were endorsed by the latter's Regional Director to the Chairman of the LTFRB, through the Office of the Executive Director for appropriate action/instruction;

WHEREAS, it is known in the public land transportation industry that PM Jeepney is an association formed and organized under existing laws of the Philippines composed of operators and drivers, in the national level, objective of which is to protect the interest of its members which are either cooperatives/corporations or unincorporated organizations from regional or local level;

WHEREAS, after evaluation and review of the records available, this Board resolved to allow the withdrawal of Applications of PM Jeepney, and endorsed the routes applied for to its member cooperatives/corporation which are part of its umbrella organization;

NOW THEREFORE, for and consideration of the foregoing, the Board hereby directs LTFRB Regional Office III to promptly and favorably act on the said Motions filed under Case Nos. RFRO-III-201800524, RFRO-III-201800521, RFRO-III-201800520, RFRO-III-201800522, RFRO-III-201800523, RFRO-III-201800525, and RFRO-III-201800526, subject to the following conditions:

1. Payment of filing fees for Motions and other related charges;
2. Filing of appropriate pleadings for change of party applicant; and

3. New party applicants shall strictly comply with the conditions provided under the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP).


