**RESOLUTION NO. 217 Series of 2020**

(Re: Accreditation of TM-11 Enterprises  
as a GPS Device Provider)

**WHEREAS**, on 19 November 2019, the Pre-Accreditation Committee for GPS Device Providers issued a Resolution numbered 267 series of 2019 wherein the Committee resolved:

**“NOW THEREFORE**, the Pre Qualification Committee resolves, as it hereby resolved to:

1. **GRANT** the Motion for Reconsideration as it established with merit the allegations contained thereat, **SETTING ASIDE** Resolution No. 020 Series of 2019 dated 2 April 2019, and
2. For the applicant to submit Formal Offer of Evidence containing therein the requirements set forth under **Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013, 2015-015A, 2015-024 and 2016-016**, within **Ten (10) days** from receipt hereof without any extension;”

**WHEREAS**, on 25 November 2019, applicant TM-11 Enterprises received the abovementioned resolution and submitted its compliance on 4 December 2019. An evaluation was thereafter conducted by the Committee and a recommendation was made on 11 September 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee found that TM-11 Enterprises still failed to submit the Contact Person, address and telephone/mobile number of their list of clients in the transportation industry as required under Memorandum Circular No. 2016-016 and the NBI Clearance of its declared installer/technician named Scherjeamlhaine Arndthkeathe M. Casaje;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee also found that TM-11 Enterprises still proposes a dashboard camera device rather than an appropriate or proper GNSS device/tracker/receiver that conforms to the specifications set forth by the Board in coordination with the Department of Science and Technology - Advance Science and Technology (DOST-ASTI) under Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013, 2015-024 and 2016-016. A dashboard camera does not fall under the category of a true GNSS device;

**WHEREAS**, a dashboard camera and a GNSS receiver are different devices/accessories and are both required to Public Utility Vehicles for the implementation of the PUVMP under the DOTr Department Order No. 2017-011;

**NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered, the Pre-Accreditation Committee resolves, as it is hereby resolved to **DENY** the application of TM-11 Enterprises for a Certificate of Accreditation as a GPS Device Provider for failure to comply with the requirement set forth under Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013, 2015-024 and 2016-016. This is however without prejudice on its part to re-apply for accreditation subject to the completion of the requirements and the conformity of the proposed GNSS device.
