BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 009
Series of 2021

WHEREAS, on 11 September 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed into Law the Republic Act No. 11494, otherwise known as the Bayanihan to Recover as One Act, which mandates the implementation of a comprehensive program to address the multifarious need of the Filipino people to recover from COVID-19 pandemic which included the adversely affected transport sector;

WHEREAS, part of the COVID-19 Response and Recovery Interventions under Section 4, paragraph (fff) of said Act, the DOTr is directed to coordinate and negotiate for partially subsidized service contracting of public utility vehicles (PUVs) as a form of temporary relief to critically impacted workers in the public transportation sector, which at the same raising the level of service of the modes of public transport covered by this program;

WHEREAS, the DOTr, in the exercise of its mandate, to call upon any agency to participate and assist in the preparation and implementation of its program, designate the LTFRB as the implementing agency in the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the Service Contracting Program;

WHEREAS, on 9 November 2020, the Board issued Resolution No. 205, authorizing Joel J. Bolano to sign on behalf of the Board, all Disbursement Vouchers and other related documents needed for the payment of subsidy;

WHEREAS, due to the workload and other important assigned tasks currently handled by Mr. Joel Bolano, the Board sees the need to designate and authorize another officer which resolved to authorize Mr. Mario Tuscan Naz to sign on behalf of the Board, all Disbursement Vouchers and other related documents in connection with the activities relative to Service Contracting Program.

WHEREAS, due to the resignation of Mr. Mario Tuscan Naz, the Board sees the need to designate and authorize another officer, so as to expedite the payment to identified beneficiaries of the Program.

WHEREAS, in the processing of payout to identified eligible PUV operators and drivers, Disbursement Vouchers and other related documents are needed;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board **RESOLVES** as it hereby **RESOLVED** to **AUTHORIZE DIOSDADO B. SANTIAGO, JR.** to **SIGN**, on behalf of the Board, all Disbursement Vouchers and other related documents in connection with the activities relative to Service Contracting Program.

Accordingly, the Board Resolution No. 205, series of 2020 issued on 9 November 2020 is hereby deemed **REPEALED**.
