BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 022
Series of 2021

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) was created by Executive Order No. 202 on June 19, 1987, as administrative agency with quasi-judicial powers, and is the existing franchising and regulatory body for land transportation today;

WHEREAS, from the assumption of His Excellency Rodrigo Roa Duterte as President of the Republic of the Philippines, the Board has instituted reforms for the modernization of public land transportation services

WHEREAS On June 19, 2017, Department Order No. 2017-011, Re: OMNIBUS FRANCHISING GUIDELINES ON THE PLANNING AND IDENTIFICATION OF PUBLIC ROAD TRANSPORTATION SERVICE AND FRANCHISE ISSUANCE was issued by the Secretary of Department, or the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP), a flagship program of the government which envisions a restructured, modern, well-managed and environmentally sustainable transport sector where drivers and operators have stable, sufficient and dignified livelihoods while commuters get to their destinations quickly, safely and comfortably;

WHEREAS, pursuant thereto, the Board has issued circulars and resolutions opening routes and services for issuance of Certificates of Public Convenience, subject to the selection/pre-qualifying process being implemented;

WHEREAS, the implementation of modernization program has improved existing public land transportation service, such as the opening of provincial PUB routes with modernized buses, introduction of Point to Point Service, and the upgrade of conventional PUJ Service and UV Express Service to Class 2 PUJ or Electric PUJ Service and Class 3, respectively;

WHEREAS, the implementation of PUVMP was partially suspended due to the public health crisis brought about by COVID19 disease, which resulted adverse economic impact in our country;

WHEREAS, the Board has instituted reforms to proceed for the implementation of PUVMP, and as such individual grantees of PUB, PUJ and UV Services have filed the necessary applications to comply with the industry consolidation, and have been commencing substitution and re-fleeting of units to comply with the specifications and standards for modernized units;

WHEREAS, the Board agreed that there is a need to promptly dispose all Petitions of substitution of units and Provisional Authority pursuant to

PUVMP in order not to prejudice those who complied with the conditions set forth under DP 2017-001

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board hereby **RESOLVES,** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to authorize **BOARD MEMBER JOEL C. PERNITO** to act for and in behalf of the Board and to sign the ALL Orders of Provisional Authority and Substitution of Units pursuant to PUVMP, after evaluation of the Technical Division of this Board.
