BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 030
Series of 2021

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2017, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 2017-011 (Re: Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance) adopting the rules and procedures for the issuance of franchises for public transport routes and services;

WHEREAS, on 11 October 2019, the Board issued a Notice of Compliance for the LPTRP of Oriental Mindoro Province;

WHEREAS, on 01 December 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No 2020-080 re: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) of Oriental Mindoro under the Implementation of Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP), which included therein the route of Bongabong – Pinamalayan as new/developmental route;

WHEREAS, it was later on revealed based on records that the route Bongabong – Pinamalayan is an existing rationalized route, with existing PUVs operating on the said route under Board Resolution No. 53 series of 2018;

WHEREAS, the opening of Application for Issuance of New CPC on the route Bongabong – Pinamalayan will not only cause undue competition but will have an adverse effect to the operation of the existing operators on the said route;


NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the LTFRB RFRO No. IV-B is directed to immediately **CEASE AND DESIST** from accepting and processing any Applications for Issuance of New CPC particularly on the route of **Bongabong – Pinamalayan**, Oriental Mindoro.
