MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 2021-044

SUBJECT : SUPPLEMENT TO MC 2020-023 ON THE GUIDELINES FOR THE OPERATIONS OF OFG-COMPLIANT PUJ VEHICLES DURING THE PERIOD OF GCQ IN METRO MANILA

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-023 on the resumption of operations for OFG compliant PUJ units starting 22 June 2020 during the period of the General Community Quarantine (GCQ) in Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, under Annex "A" of said Circular, several routes have been included for OFG-compliant units to ply their original routes (original route structure prior to the declaration of Enhanced Community Quarantine last 17 March 2020)

WHEREAS, based on the monitoring of resumption of operations on said routes, there is a need to increase the number of existing OFG-compliant units plying said routes to meet the corresponding increase of passenger demand;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the number of authorized OFG-compliant units is deemed amended/increased to supplement Memorandum Circular No. 2020-023 as follows:

ROUTE	No. of Authorized Units under MC 2020 - 023	No. of Additional NAUs	Total NAU
Cubao – Sta. Lucia, Pasig	30	12	42

In this regard, existing OFG-compliant operators plying the abovementioned routes shall be allowed to resume operations immediately, without need of Special Permit provided they have a copy of the valid Provisional Authority and must secure a QR Code prior to operation. Said operators shall comply with the health and operational requirements required by the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) and Department of Transportation (DOTr) Guidelines on Public Transport under GCQ.

All other provisions of MC 2020-023 are deemed incorporated herein.

Applicant/operator shall abide by the results of the Route Rationalization Study or LPTRP of the PUVMP once completed.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation. Let three (3) copies hereof be filed with the UP Law Center – Office of National Administrative Registrar (ONAR).
