**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 094**  
**Series of 2021**

**WHEREAS**, the looming threat of the more contagious variant has prompted President Rodrigo Ra Duterte to approved the recommendation Inter Agency Task Force to place Metro Manila under Enhanced Community Quarantine from August 6 to 20, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, after the discussions by the Department of Transportation and the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF), the former's proposal of retaining the current supply and 50% capacity in public utility vehicles (PUV) was approved, which allowed the continued operation of public transportation, but only authorized persons outside residence (APORs) will be accommodated;

**WHEREAS**, it should be recalled that the government through the IATF-EID has implemented a calibrated and gradual resumption of public land transportation services, and the Board issued circulars for the operations of Public Utility Vehicles during the period of General Community Quarantine and Modified General Community Quarantine, wherein special permits to operate and QR Codes were correspondingly issued

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board hereby **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to **ALLOW** grantees of Certificates of Public Convenience or Provisional Authority which were allowed to resume operations by way of Special Permit or QR Codes during the period of General Community Quarantine (GCQ) and Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) to **CONTINUE OPERATIONS** during the period of Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in Metro Manila, as may be allowed by the IATF, subject to the following:

1. Operators/drivers shall strictly ensure that only Authorized Persons Outside Residence (APORs) are permitted to use public transport;
2. Operators/drivers shall remind passengersto be ready to present to transport marshals identification cards issued by the IATF or other documents or IDs as proof that they are authorized to travel; and
3. Guidelines provided under IATF Resolution No. 130-A shall be observed and followed.
4. Issuances of the Board relating to the health and safety protocols before and during operations must be strictly complied with.


