BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 110
Series of 2021

WHEREAS, on 16 June 2021, the DOTr has issued Department Order No. 2021-009, extending the effectivity of Department Order No. 2020-017, which aside from designating the Land Transportation and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) as the Implementing Agency for the said Program, it also provides for the functions of Implementation Committee and Oversight Committee, for the purpose of continuous implementation of the Service Contracting Program under RA No. 11518, otherwise known as the 2021 General Appropriations Act (GAA);

WHEREAS, the Board, on 2 September 2021, issued Memorandum Circular No. 2021-054, prescribing the implementing guidelines on the PUV Service Contracting Program under the General Appropriations Act of 2021;

WHEREAS, one of the types of Service Contracting mentioned under MC No. 2021-054 is the Gross Service Contracting Exclusive for Health Care Workers (HCW), intended to provide free rides to Medical Health Workers in routes that may be provided by the Central Office or the RFROs;

WHEREAS, in the previous Service Contracting Program which was sourced from R.A No. 11494, otherwise known as Bayanihan to Recover as One Act, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2021-008, attaching therewith a list of routes identified by the Central Office for the Gross Service Contracting intended to provide freerides to Medical Health Workers;

WHEREAS, it has been observed that the routes listed under Annex "A" of MC 2021-008 are still the same routes with the highest passenger demand for Medical Health Workers;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board resolves as it hereby resolved to **ADOPT** the routes identified under Annex "A" of Memorandum Circular No. 2021-008 as the same routes to be catered by the Gross Service Contracting for Medical Health Workers mentioned under Par. III.A of Memorandum Circular No. 2021-054.

Further, consistent to the provisions of MC No. 2021-054, it is reiterated that the Regional Franchising and Regulatory Offices (RFROs) may identify and issue list of routes to be catered by the Gross Service Contracting for Medical Health Workers mentioned under Par. III.A of Memorandum Circular No. 2021-054 within its respective territorial jurisdiction.

Since these identified routes are not the original routes authorized to the PUV operators, and which is only for the duration of the Gross Service Contracting, PUVs enrolled must secure **Special Permits** from the LTFRB Central Office or RFROs concerned. The operations of PUVs enrolled herein shall in no case cause abandonment of their existing operational route.
