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**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 111**  
**Series of 2021**

**WHEREAS**, on 11 September 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed into law the Republic Act No. 11494, otherwise known as the Bayanihan to Recover as Once Act, which mandates the implementation of a comprehensive program to address the multifarious need of the Filipino People to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic which included the adversely affected transport sector;

**WHEREAS**, subsequently, Republic Act No. 11519 was enacted, extending the availability of appropriations under Republic Act No. 11494, otherwise known as the Bayanihan to Recover As One Act (or “Bayanihan II”, which includes, among others the automatic appropriations of new programs, projects, and activities pursuant to Section 4 thereof, which shall be available for release, obligation and disbursement until June 30, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, under said law, the DOTr was directed to implement the Service Contracting Program to support to road-based public transport stakeholders which was identified as among those critically impacted sector due to the pandemic, and by virtue of which, the DOTr designated the LTFRB as the implementing agency of said Program;

**WHEREAS**, as of June 30, 2021, the unutilized funds from the PUV Service Contracting Program under Bayanihan II amounting to approximately Three Billion Three Hundred Thirty-Eight Million Pesos (Php 3,338,000,000.00) was reverted by the LTFRB to the Department of Transportation, and subsequently to the Bureau of Treasury;

**WHEREAS**, in order to facilitate the payment of the pending/unpaid payouts to the participants who rendered their services until June 30, 2021, the Department of Budget and Management approved the return of the needed funds to the DOTr and eventually to LTFRB;

**WHEREAS**, in order to process the actual payment for services rendered to the beneficiaries, there is a need to prepare all necessary documentary requirements pursuant to the regulation of Commission on Audit (COA), as well as that of the LandBank of the Philippines, where the account is maintained;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board hereby resolves as it is resolved to AUTHORIZE Mr. Joel J. Bolano – Chief of the LTFRB Technical Division to SIGN, for and on behalf of the LTFRB, all documents necessary for the processing of payments to the beneficiaries of the Service Contracting Program under Bayanihan II until such time as the incoming Executive Director could assume office and take over the task necessary for the processing of pending payables under Bayanihan II and the implementation of the Service Contracting Program under GAA 2021.


