**RESOLUTION NO. 117 Series of 2021**

(re: Accreditation of SMESOFT, INC.  
as Transportation Network Company)

**WHEREAS**, on 12 October 2020, herein Applicant, SMESOFT, Inc. filed its Motion for Reconsideration based on the decision of the Pre-Accreditation Committee under Resolution No. 030, series of 2020 denying its Application for Accreditation for lack of merit and on the ground of laches;

**WHEREAS**, it may be recalled that as early as June 2018, herein Applicant had already filed its Application for Accreditation, but was repeatedly denied thru Resolution Nos. 070, series of 2018 and 030, series of 2020 on the ground of deficiencies in the documentary requirements, despite giving the Applicant ample opportunities to comply with the requirements;

**WHEREAS**, the dispositive portion of Resolution No. 030, series of 2020 reads:

“NOW THEREFORE, the Pre-Accreditation Committee resolves, as it hereby resolved to **Deny** this Motion for lack of merit and on the ground of laches, without prejudice on the part of herein applicant to re-submit application for accreditation in the event the Board lifts the Moratorium on the acceptance of application for TNC Accreditation.”

**WHEREAS**, in purposely placing the phrase, “without prejudice on the part of herein applicant to re-submit application for accreditation in the event the Board lifts the Moratorium on the acceptance of application for TNC Accreditation” was meant to convey that the decision of the Pre-Accreditation Committee is already Final on account of the applicant’s repeated failure to comply with the requirements;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Pre-Accreditation Committee hereby recommends to the Board to **DENY** the Motion for Reconsideration of herein Applicant, without prejudice on the part of the applicant to file an Appeal, or re-submit an Application once the moratorium on the acceptance of Application for TNC Accreditation is lifted by the Board.


