BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 132
Series of 2021

WHEREAS, one of the powers and functions of Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) under Section 5(k) of Executive Order 202 is to formulate, promulgate, administer, implement and enforce rules and regulations on land transportation public utilities...xxx...xxx...xxx;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Department Order No. 2018-009 issued by the Department of Transportation authorizing the LTFRB to impound and dispose vehicles, considerable number of colorum vehicles have been apprehended and impounded already which necessitates the Board to look for sizable impounding area;

WHEREAS, in a Memorandum signed by Regional Director of RFRO No. 9, PBGen. Johnson C. Almazan, (Ret.) dated 14 October 2021, he mentioned that the City of Pagadian City, thru Mayor Samuel S. Co, has approved the request of the LTFRB RFRO No. 9 to donate a three thousand (3,000) square meters lot located at Regional Center, Balintawak, Pagadian City to be used by LTFRB RFRO No. 9 as its vehicle impounding area and office building;

WHEREAS, also stated in the said Memorandum is the request of the City Government of Pagadian for the Board to designate a duly authorized official to sign for and in behalf of the agency on the Deed of Donation;

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the transfer of title of the subject property, the prompt execution and processing of legal and other necessary documents are equally important;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board resolves as it hereby resolved to **DELEGATE** to the LTFRB RFRO No. 9 Regional Director, PBGen. **JOHNSON C. ALMAZAN**, to **SIGN** the Deed of Donation and other documents necessary for the transfer of the subject property from the City Government of Pagadian to the LTFRB RFRO No. 9.
