**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 137**  
**Series of 2021**

**WHEREAS**, on 19 June 2017, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 2017-011 (Re: Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance) which aims to provide a reliable, safe, accessible, environment-friendly, dependable, efficient, and comfortable public land transportation throughout the country;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 5(a) of Executive Order No. 202, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) shall have the power “to prescribe and regulate routes of service, economically viable capacities and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles;

**WHEREAS**, the DOTr has given the LTFRB the authority to deliberate and take appropriate action on proposed new/additional routes pursuant to the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP);

**WHEREAS**, on 15 March 2019, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013 also known as “Consolidated Guidelines on the Process of Issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) and Provisional Authority (PA) / Special Permit (SP) under the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines & Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP)”;

**WHEREAS**, the Selection Process has been conducted for the new/developmental routes under the following Memorandum Circulars before the declaration of community quarantine in the Philippines on the onset of COVID-19 to wit:

**WHEREAS**, in December 2019, the World Health Organization was alerted of several respiratory cases which were later on attributed to what is now known as the “Corona Virus Disease (COVID 19)”;

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Proclamation No. 922 entitled “*Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency Throughout the Philippines*” on 08 March 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the Board has selected some operators and their corresponding notice of selection was issued to them. Further, the application of other operators has been processed but the issuance of notice of selection was suspended because of the COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, to date, the COVID 19 infection rate in the Philippines has substantially declined, along with the lowering of quarantine alert level status of Metro Manila and nearby provinces, the number of commuters is expected to increase as the Philippines is gradually opening its economy;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to proceed with all pending processes involving the Selection Process for the following routes:

Accordingly, the use of interim units per MC 2019-013 shall no longer be applicable. Instead, OFG-Compliant units shall be required for selected entities.


Once an operator has been selected and issued a Notice of Selection, the corresponding Provisional Authority and QR Codes shall be subsequently issued after the submission of the required documents and subject to existing policies of the Board. No units shall be allowed to operate without the needed Provisional Authority and QR Codes.

All operators issued with NOS shall be given until June 30, 2022 to file their Application for Issuance of CPC with OFG compliant units. Failure to comply with the timeline shall automatically cause the revocation of the NOS and shall result in the commencement of new selection process for the route involved.

Applicant operators shall abide by the results of the Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP) or Route Rationalization studies.
