BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 140
Series of 2021

WHEREAS, when President Rodrigo Roa Duterte placed the entire Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine on 6 March 2020, restrictions were likewise imposed particularly the movement of population in response to the increasing number of COVID-19 cases in the country;

WHEREAS, following the easing of quarantine level in the country, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-EID) has allowed the operation of public transportation under limited and reduced passenger capacity in areas placed under General Community Quarantine (GCQ);

WHEREAS, relevant Issuances were passed prescribing the guidelines for the gradual and calibrated resumption of operation of public land transportation subject to the approval of concerned Local Government Units (LGUs) and coordination with the AITF;

WHEREAS, in view of the continued decline of infection rate in the country along with the de-escalation of Alert Level in most part of the country, and as the operations of public land transportation services were further relaxed, increasing the number of routes opened, including passenger capacity, Special Permit during Special Occasions or Activities such as excursions, family trip/festivity, attendance to seminars/conference and the like, and during Special Holidays should also be allowed;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board resolves as it hereby resolved to allow the resumption of acceptance of Application for Issuance of Special Permit during Special Occasions or Activities and during Special Holidays, subject to the conditions set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2015-008 and MC 2016-014 and the applicable provisions in the 2020 Citizen's Charter (Special Permit) particularly as regards the venue for filing of Application for Special Permit.

The operation of PUVs with Special Permit granted under this Resolution shall abide the travel requirements and health protocols of the concerned LGU of origin and destination, in coordination with the IATF.

Further, relevant issuances on the imposition of health protocols inside PUVs must be strictly observed.
