RESOLUTION NO. 151 Series of 2021

(Re: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New CPC for the route: Davao City, Davao Del Sur to Marawi City, Lanao Del Sur under MC No. 2021-072)

WHEREAS, before this Committee are the applications of the following:

1. Mindanao Star Bus Transport, Inc.; and
2. PABAMA Corporation

for the route Davao City, Davao Del Sur – Marawi City, Lanao Del Sur route with the use of fifteen (15) authorized Public Utility Bus (PUB) units, under the initial selection/qualification process conducted on 1 December 2021;

WHEREAS, the proceedings conducted by the Selection Committee was shown Live at LTFRB Facebook page, in the presence of the Applicant's counsel and authorized representatives via Zoom;

WHEREAS, after due evaluation of the qualification documents submitted by both Applicants, and some clarifications asked from the authorized counsel/representatives, Mindanao Star Bus Transport, Inc. and PABAMA Corporation **PASSED** the Legal, Technical and Financial requirements;

WHEREAS, it is provided under Memorandum Circular No. 2021-072 that the selection of qualified applicant shall be processed following the provisions of Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, also known as the Consolidated Guidelines on the Process of Issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC), and Provisional Authority;

WHEREAS, perused from the submission of Mindanao Star Bus Transport, Inc., it declared eight (8) ready and available compliant units, duly supported by photocopies of Official Receipt and Certificate of Registration (OR/CR), the remaining seven (7) units are supported by an Undertaking to complete/comply on 5 May 2022, as certified by its supplier;

WHEREAS, PABAMA Corporation on the other hand, submitted six (6) ORs for its ready and available units, but only five (5) of them are duly supported by OR/CR, the remaining units are supported by an Undertaking to complete/comply within three (3) months. Pursuant to item V.B.(1) of Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, the number of compliant units available must be supported by OR/CR. Considering that only five (5) units are duly supported with OR/CR, only five (5) shall then be considered;

WHEREAS, pursuant to item V.B.(3) of Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, the Applicant-Operators who **PASSED** the legal, technical and financial qualifications ***shall be ranked based on the availability of the required number of compliant units. Higher rank is accorded to an applicant with the highest number of ready and available units***, then on the schedule of delivery of the units (as certified by the supplier/manufacturer) on a first-in-time basis;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, this Committee hereby resolves to **RECOMMEND** to the Board to **AWARD** the route Davao City, Davao Del Sur – Marawi City, Lanao Del Sur with the use fifteen (15) units to **MINDANAO STAR BUS TRANSPORT, INC.**, for having passed the legal, technical and financial requirements, and for submitting a higher number of ready and available compliant units compared to PABAMA Corporation.


