BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 154
Series of 2021

WHEREAS, on 1 December 2021, the Board issued Board Resolution No. 140, series of 2021 primarily to address the increasing demand for the issuance of Special Permit during Special Occasions or Activities such as excursions, family trip/festivity, attendance to seminars/conference and the like, and during Special Holidays, in light of the easing of restrictions imposed by the government;

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board, after validation conducted by the Franchise Planning and Monitoring Division (FPMD), that a considerable number of PUVs granted with Special Permit and QR Code to operate on their routes during Community Quarantine are not actually operating, causing an imbalance between the operational PUVs and passenger demand;

WHEREAS, it is imperative upon the Board to impose a strict policy on the issuance of Special Permit or QR Code in this time of pandemic for the purpose of orderly operation of public transportation and to maintain sufficient number of PUVs necessary to serve the commuting public especially during holidays;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board resolves as it is hereby resolved to **CLARIFY** in the previous Resolution No. 140, series of 2021 that the issuance of **Special Permit** shall be allowed during Special Holidays pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2015-008 provided that the requirements for application for QR Code issuance stated in MCs 2020-051 and 2021-023 shall be complied with.
