**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 02**  
**SERIES OF 2022**

**WHEREAS**, on 14 May 2020, Memorandum Circular No.2020-019 was issued which approved the following bus routes: (1) Route 2: Monumento – PITX; (2) Route 6: Quezon Avenue – PITX (as amended by MC2021-016); and (3) Route 13: PITX-BGC;

**WHEREAS**, on 12 January 2022, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) announced that the southbound portion of Roxas Boulevard will be closed to vehicular traffic starting January 15, 2022 to give way to the repairs to be undertaken by the of Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) in front of Libertad Pumping Station, and which repair will last for a period of two (2) months;

**WHEREAS**, on 14 January 2022, the Franchise Planning and Monitoring Division (FPMD) proposed to the Board alternate southbound route structure for affected three (3) bus routes as abovementioned, with clearance sought from the MMDA;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need for the modification of the existing bus routes identified for the duration of the repair to provide guidance for the bus operators of said routes;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board hereby **RESOLVES** as it is resolved to **APPROVE** and **ADOPT** the recommendation of the FPMD as follows:

**Alternate SOUTHBOUND Route Structure:**

1. Buendia Avenue
2. Diosdado Macapagal Boulevard
3. EDSA Extension
4. Globe Rotonda (MOA)
5. EDSA Extension
6. Diosdado Macapagal Boulevard
7. PITX

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the above route structure shall apply to all three (3) routes, namely: (1) Route 2: Monumento – PITX; (2) Route 6: Quezon Avenue – PITX; and (3) Route 13: PITX-BGC for a period of two (2) months, or until the MMDA has declared the re-opening Roxas Boulevard to traffic;

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, that proper information dissemination, enforcement, and monitoring be undertaken by the Technical Division (TD) and FPMD.
