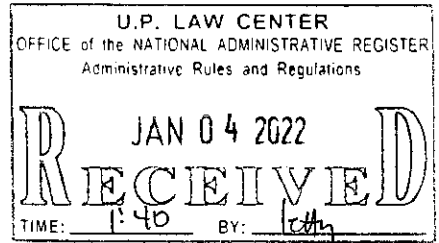

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2021 - 078

SUBJECT: OPENING OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF NEW CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE (CPC) OF THE APPROVED ROUTES OF SABLAYAN, OCCIDENTAL MINDORO LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT ROUTE PLAN (LPTRP) UNDER THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE MODERNIZATION PROGRAM (PUVMP)

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2017, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 2017 – 011 also known as the Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of the Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance adopting the rules and procedures for the issuance of the franchises for public transport routes and services;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(a) of Executive Order No. 202, dated 19 June 1987, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) shall have the power to “prescribe and regulate routes of service, economically viable capacities and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles, xxxxx”;

WHEREAS, the DOTr has given LTFRB the authority to deliberate and take appropriate action on proposed new/additional routes pursuant to the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP) and Memorandum Circular No. 2018-006;

WHEREAS, the Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP) of Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro was reviewed and evaluated by the third-party consultant, Transport and Traffic Planners Inc. (TTPI), and recommended for the issuance of Notice of Compliance (NOC). On 12 November 2019, the LTFRB RFRO 4 issued NOC to Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro, approved and signed by Regional Director Col. Renwick K. Rutaquio directing the Sangguniang Bayan to pass a Special Ordinance adopting the said LPTRP pursuant to the OFG and the Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 001, s. 2017 between DOTr and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), or the Guidelines on the Preparation and Issuance of Local Ordinances, Orders, Rules and Regulations concerning the Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP);

WHEREAS, Sangguniang Bayan in the Municipality of Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro passed Special Ordinance No. 2020-SO076: “Ordinance adopting the Local Public Transport Route Plan 2018-2023 of the Municipality of Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro and for other purposes”, approved and signed by Municipal Mayor Andres D. Dangeros dated 23 March 2020;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Ordinance, a total of ten (10) new/developmental routes have been approved;

NOW THEREFORE, upon the recommendation of the LTFRB and DOTr, the following New/Developmental routes with corresponding Route Survey Information are hereby approved for the issuance of New CPCs:

Only those units compliant with the OFG and DTI – PNS shall be accepted.

For Routes 1 and 3 to 10, the NAU is below 15 units because the passenger demand on a daily basis does not suffice the minimum fleet size required for new/developmental routes.

For **NEW/DEVELOPMENTAL** routes, the provisions of MC 2019-013 shall apply. The pre-qualification conferences shall be held at LTFRB Regional Office No. 4-B on **10 February 2022 at 2:00 PM.**

Letter of Intent and qualification documents shall be submitted **NOT LATER THAN** the indicated deadline below:

Opening of the sealed documents will immediately follow at **10:00 AM of the same date.**

A qualified Applicant may be selected for more than one (1) route and subsequently processed for the grant of CPC following the provisions of Memorandum Circular No. 2019–013 also known as the Consolidated Guidelines on the Process of Issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC), and Provisional Authority (PA)/Special Permit (SP) under the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines & Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP) dated 15 March 2019.

In case of failure on the initial qualification process, interested applicants shall be given ten (10) working days reckoned from the date when the initial qualification has been declared a failure to file their Letter of Intent and qualification documents.

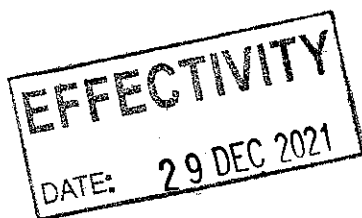
