## RESOLUTION NO. OO6 Series of 2022

(re: Application for Accreditation of CLOUD PANDA PH, INC. as Transportation Network Company)

WHEREAS, relative to the issued Memorandum Circular No. 2021-066, lifting the moratorium in the acceptance of Application for Accreditation of Transport Network Company (TNC), herein Applicant, Cloud Panda Ph, Inc. (Cloud Panda for brevity) submitted its Application to the Pre-Accreditation Committee (PAC) on 2 December 2021;

"NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the PAC hereby recommends to the Board to allow herein Applicant, Cloud Panda Ph, Inc. to finally comply and submit the following documents, within fifteen (15) days from receipt of this Resolution:

- 1. Business Permit duly issued by the Local Government where the Applicant's principal place of business is located
- 2. Terms of Service for Passengers
- 3. Terms of Service for TNVS Operators
- 4. The provision on the "Liability" portion that it shall exercise due diligence of a good father of a family in accrediting and supervising its TNVS partners and drivers, and that it shall be held liable for acts or omissions committed by its TNVS while online, except if the same is beyond the TNC's control.

Failure of the applicant to submit the foregoing requirements shall be a ground for the denial of its Application, without benefit of any or further compliance."

WHEREAS, on 21 January 2022, Cloud Panda submitted its compliance to the Resolution, attaching therein the requirements;

**WHEREAS**, the PAC had convened thru Teleconference on 27 January 2022 to evaluate the submission of herein Applicant, and after due examination of the documents, the same have duly complied with all the requirements set forth under the Memorandum Circular No. 2021-066;

WHEREAS, Cloud Panda submitted its Business Permit duly issued by the City Government of Pasig dated 17 January 2022 valid until 31 December 2022.

WHEREAS, Cloud Panda submitted its Terms and Conditions containing its Liability to Passengers and Liability to Driver/Operator and Passengers which reads:

"When a sudden, external and identifiable event that happens by chance and could not have been expected from the perspective of either the driver or the passenger, Cloud Panda shall be liable for any death, injury, damage, or loss occurred. Cloud Panda shall cover the entire trip, from when the driver confirms the booking and the passenger boards the vehicle up to when they reach the drop-off point. This covers the nationwide operations of the company.

The company, Cloud Panda wants to protect its drivers and passengers against the financial impact of injuries and/or deaths resulting from accident involving a registered driver. Registered vehicles, including those without PA or CPC yet are automatically enrolled to the insurance program without having to pay a premium and deductible.

Cloud Panda shall follow the "no fault policy" which means passengers can receive full accident insurance benefits regardless of who's at fault during the road crash."

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the PAC hereby recommends to the Board to **GRANT** herein Applicant, Cloud Panda Ph, Inc. its Certificate of Accreditation as a Transport Network Company (TNC) pursuant to the provisions set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2021-066.

Furthermore, the grantee shall be ready and available in the market to accept Transport Network Vehicle Services issued with the necessary authority to operate i.e., Provisional Authority and/or Certificate of Public Convenience, relative to its immediate and significant operations of the grantee as a TNC, within thirty (30) days from receipt of its Certificate of Accreditation.
