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**RESOLUTION NO. 021 Series of 2022**

(Re: Application of Green Horizon General Transport Services, Inc. for the route: Brgy. Paliparan, Dasmarinas, Cavite to PITX via Molino under Memorandum Circular No. 2018-027)

**WHEREAS**, on 28 October 2019, Green Horizon General Transport Services, Inc. filed its letter of intent and qualification documents to apply for the route BRGY. PALIPARAN, DASMARIÑAS, CAVITE TO PITX VIA MOLINO under Memorandum Circular No. 2018-027 with the use of fifteen (15) Class 3 UV units and the selection proceedings was thereafter conducted on 19 February 2020;

**WHEREAS**, Green Horizon General Transport Services, Inc. have complied with the Legal Qualifications set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee found that Green Horizon General Transport Services, Inc. has submitted (1) a Proforma Invoice dated 27 September 2019 from Aspire Autoparts and Repair Services, Inc. duly signed by its President - Steven Rhine C. Claros relative to the applicant's proposed fifteen (15) JAC HK6739K units, (2) letter-quotation dated 20 September 2019 from Aspire Autoparts and Repair Services, Inc., duly signed by its VP-Marketing - Chrysler E. Panganiban, indicating the specifications of the fifteen (15) JAC HK6739K series and that the total contract price is amounting to Php 42,750,000.00, and (3) an undated Purchase Order by the applicant which indicates Aspire Autoparts and Repair Services, Inc. as its supplier, fifteen (15) Ankai/JAC HK6739K units amounting to Php 2,856,000.00 each prepared and signed by the applicant's secretary - Chona R. Parong;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee found that Green Horizon General Transport Services, Inc. failed to include/submit in its qualification documents the following substantial documentary requirements set forth in Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013:

1. Undertaking that 25% of the number of required units within three (3) months, 50% within six (6) months, 100% within nine (9) months will be delivered as certified by the vehicle manufacturer/supplier;
2. Undertaking that the units shall be compliant with the specifications and standards under OFG and DTI-PNS;
3. Undertaking that Green Horizon General Transport Services, Inc. will immediately comply with the approved DOTr/LPTRP rationalization study;
4. Organized vehicle dispatch procedures for its Fleet Management System;
5. Evidence of formal arrangement with Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) service provider that will offer inter-operable AFC service that is fully compliant with fare media related technical specifications;
6. Copies of Letter of Support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in BRGY. PALIPARAN, DASMARIÑAS, CAVITE endpoint;

7. Manner of acquisition for the compliant PUV units identifying the funding source and with detailed financing plan;
8. Financial projections for the first five (5) years of operations, showing detailed revenues and costs, as well as projected demand, including assumptions made;

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Proclamation No. 922 entitled "Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency Throughout the Philippines" on 8 March 2020 relative to the alert of World Health Organization in December 2019 on the threat of COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, the Selection Process has been conducted for the new/developmental routes under the Memorandum Circular No. 2018-027 before the declaration of community quarantine in the Philippines on the onset of COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, on 24 November 2021, the Board has issued its Resolution numbered 137 S. 2021 to proceed with all pending processes involving the Selection Process for the herein route;

**NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered, this Committee resolves to **DENY** the application of Green Horizon General Transport Services, Inc. for failure to comply with the documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013. This is however without prejudice on its part to re-apply or submit its application again but is subject to availability of the total number of required units for the subject route.
