MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2022-025

**Subject : ADDITIONAL ROUTES ALLOWED FOR THE OPERATION OF
UV EXPRESS DURING THE PERIOD OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE
COVERING ROUTES NOT TOUCHING METRO MANILA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the guidelines of the Department of Transportation (DOTr) for a calibrated and gradual opening of public transportation, the Board has since then made the necessary monitoring on the daily operations of the initial routes allowed to operate;

WHEREAS, on 26 June 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-025 on the resumption of operations of UV Express service starting 03 July 2020 during the period of General Community Quarantine (GCQ) in Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, under Item 2.b. of MC 2020-025, the Board may issue additional routes to resume operations based on passenger demand;

WHEREAS, on 25 September 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular 2020-051 which allowed the resumption of operations of select Provincial Bus routes entering Metro Manila, and under Item II thereof, the Board may issue additional routes to resume operations upon approval and coordination with the concerned Local Government Unit (LGU);

WHEREAS, based on the monitoring and coordination by LTFRB CAR Regional Office with local government, Baguio City has allowed the resumption of operations of UVEs travelling to and from CAR (not touching Metro Manila) in the absence of the existing Provincial Bus routes;

WHEREAS, with proper coordination of Baguio City LGU and LTFRB CAR, the operation of UV Express has been allowed particularly those travelling to and from Baguio City to other provinces, with the condition that the UVE operators shall follow the schedules prepared by the LGU;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board hereby allows the operation of UV Express service particularly the **routes listed under "Annex A"** starting 09 February 2022, subject to the approval of LGUs concerned, and as maybe allowed by the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EIF)

Operators covered herein are required to secure QR Code for each of their authorized units prior to operation, which is downloadable at www.ltfrb.gov.ph. The requirements for the issuance of QR Code, as enumerated in Memorandum Circular No. 2021-023 are reiterated below:

Requirements:

1. Coordination with the Provincial and Local Government Units approving the resumption of operations to and from their jurisdiction;

2. Memorandum from LTFRB-RFROs addressed to the Board allowing the operation based on the Letter-Indorsement from Provincial and Local Government Units concerned;
3. Clear copies of the current LTO Official Receipts (OR) and Certificate of Registration (CR) corresponding to the number of allowed units;
4. Valid Personal Accident Insurance;

Request for QR Code including all the requirements shall be submitted or emailed to the Technical Division at mmbussp.td@ltfrb.gov.ph with the subject: **“UV Express QR OPERATOR”**. The Operator shall print the QR Code (size: 8.5”x11” short bond paper) and display conspicuously in the front windshield (without affecting the view of the driver). UVEs found to have violated the requirement herein will be apprehended accordingly.

All issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded and amended accordingly.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation. Let three (3) copies hereof be filed with the UP Law Center-Office of National Administrative Registrar (ONAR).
