BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 050
Series of 2022

WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 11639 or the General Appropriations Act (GAA) of 2022, the government has appropriated the amount of Seven Billion Pesos (P7,000,000,000.00) for the implementation of Service Contracting Program;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the special provisions of GAA 2022 and the President's veto message, the appropriated amount shall be used for the implementation of the service contracting program in accordance with the guidelines, rules and regulations to be issued by the Department of Transportation (DOTr) and the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB);

WHEREAS, subsequently, the DOTr has issued Department Order No. 2022-02 stating that, the LTFRB, as the main implementing agency of the Program, has the obligation to promulgate the necessary implementing guidelines to ensure its efficient and effective implementation;

WHEREAS, Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 2022-031 re: Implementing Guidelines on the PUV Service Contracting Program Under the General Appropriations Act of 2022, issued by the Board on 17 March 2022, did not expressly provide for any rules governing the posting of political ads on PUVs enrolled in the program;


WHEREAS, in view of the impending National and Local elections, and the existing policies of the Board, particularly, MC No. 2015-029 as supplemented by MC No. 2016-005, allowing political advertisements on PUVs, the Board is not proscribed to limit its application on certain PUVs in connection with the implementation of the service contracting program in order to avoid any appearance of undue advantage to any political candidate who might use or take advantage of the program of the government to advance their own interest;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board resolves as it hereby resolved to strictly **PROHIBIT** PUVs enrolled in the Service Contracting Program from accepting/posting political advertisements on their vehicles during the entire election period.
