RESOLUTION NO. 055 Series of 2022

(Re: Accreditation of Toyota Motor Philippines Corporation
as a GPS Device Provider)

WHEREAS, on 24 June 2021, the undersigned Chairman and Members of the Pre-Accreditation Committee issued a Resolution numbered 063 series of 2021 wherein the Committee resolved:

“NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, finding the documents submitted by Toyota Motor Philippines Corporation on 21 December 2020 to be incomplete due to its failure to submit/provide the above-mentioned documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 and 2016-016, this Committee resolves to **DIRECT** the herein applicant to **SUBMIT** to the Pre-Accreditation Committee of the same within the fifteen (15) working days from receipt of this resolution.”

WHEREAS, the documentary requirements which the applicant Toyota Motor Philippines Corporation needed to submit are the following:

1. Complete description of Business Model;
2. List of all clients (with contact person, address and telephone/mobile numbers) in the transportation industry for the last two years;
3. 24/7 Nationwide Technical Support;
4. Warranty of the GPS, which shall not less be less than than one (1) year from installation (must be signed);
5. Company policy and procedure for resolution of complaints from the operators (must be signed);
6. Secretary's Certificate of the Board/Partnership Resolution authorizing the representative to sign the Application for Accreditation for and in behalf of the corporation/partnership;
7. Secretary's Certificate of Incumbent Corporation/Partnership Officers and List of Directors/Partners;
8. Certificate of Registration duly issued by the BIR;
9. Valid Mayor's Permit;
10. Proposed Procedure for Repair and Replacement of Defective GPS Device;
11. Certificate of Registration duly issued by the Bureau of Internal Revenue for the last two years.

WHEREAS, on 11 March 2022, applicant Toyota Motor Philippines Corporation submitted its compliance to the above-mentioned resolution wherein an evaluation was thereafter conducted by the Committee and a recommendation was made on 14 March 2022;

WHEREAS, after careful and thorough evaluation of the above application and its supporting documents, the Pre-Accreditation Committee finds that the herein applicant is complete and compliant with Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 and 2016-016;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, finding the application of Toyota Motor Philippines Corporation to be complete and compliant with Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 and 2016-016, this Committee hereby **DIRECTS** the herein applicant to **CONDUCT** the necessary GPS testing procedures with the Information Systems and Management Division which the latter shall issue a recommendation to this Committee pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2020-078.
