BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 060
Series of 2022

WHEREAS, pursuant to the guidelines of the Department of Transportation (DOTr) for a calibrated and gradual opening of public transportation in Metro Manila and those in nearby provinces, the Board has since then made the necessary monitoring on the daily operations of the initial routes allowed to operate;

WHEREAS, under Item II.b. of MC 2020-026, the Board may issue additional routes to resume operations based on passenger demand;

WHEREAS, on 11 September 2020, PUJ route Grotto, San Jose del Monte, Bulacan - Novaliches was opened under MC 2020-046 with the following route structure:

Route Structure: Grotto Terminal - Quirino Highway - Novaliches and vice versa;

WHEREAS, as part of the compliance under the PUV Modernization Program, Grotto - Novaliches Transport Service Cooperative have filed for the dropping of their old units and substituting it with modernized PUJ units;

WHEREAS, the City Government of San Jose Del Monte gave support and endorsed the requested route extension to Muzon Central Terminal citing that the local government have developmental plans being achieved and is now aligned to other areas to pursue further development;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, to ensure the viability of the operations of Grotto - Novaliches Transport Service Cooperative, the Board hereby allows Grotto - Novaliches Transport Service Cooperative to operate their modernized PUJs on the requested extension of route Muzon Central Integrated Terminal, San Jose del Monte, Bulacan - Novaliches with the following route structure:

Route Structure: Novaliches Shop and Ride - Lourdes - Buenamar Dr - Sarmiento - Quirino Hwy - Belfast - Mindanao Ave - Regalado Hwy - Quirino Hwy - Gov Fortunato Halili Rd - Grotto Vista GNTSC Garage Terminal - Gov. Fernando Halili Road - M. Villarica Road - Muzon Central Integrated Terminal.

The operator shall abide by the results of the Route Rationalization Study of the PUVMP once completed.

The provisions in Memorandum Circular 2020-023 dated 19 June 2020 shall be applicable herein.

All issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded and amended accordingly.

Failure to comply with any of the conditions set forth herein may warrant the imposition of fines

and/or cancellation or suspension of the Certificate of Public Convenience or Provisional Authority of the concerned operator as the Board may determine and as provided under Joint Administrative Circular (JAO) No. 2014-001.


