RESOLUTION NO. 070 Series of 2022

(Re: Accreditation of Inav Philippines Corporation
as a GPS Device Provider)

WHEREAS, on 2 March 2022, the undersigned Chairman and Members of the Pre-Accreditation Committee issued a Resolution No. 036 S. 2022 wherein the Committee resolved thus:

“NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, finding the documents submitted by Inav Philippines Corporation on 24 January 2022 to be incomplete due to its failure to submit/provide the above-mentioned documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 and 2016-016, this Committee resolves to **DIRECT** the herein applicant to **SUBMIT** to the Pre-Accreditation Committee of the same within the fifteen (15) working days from receipt of this resolution.”

WHEREAS, the documentary requirements needed to submit, as resolved above, are the following, to wit:

- Valid of Updated Mayor's Permit/Permit to Operate; and
- Updated NBI Clearance of GPS Technicians.

WHEREAS, on 10 March 2022, herein applicant submitted its compliance to the above-mentioned resolution wherein an evaluation was thereafter conducted by the Committee and a recommendation was made on 22 March 2022;

WHEREAS, after careful and thorough evaluation of the above application and its supporting documents, the Pre-Accreditation Committee finds that the herein applicant is complete and compliant with Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 and 2016-016;

WHEREAS, on 25 November 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-078 which amends Item No. I-3 of Memorandum Circular No. 2015-013, which now prescribes that all GPS Devices must be able to send data to the server at least every ten (10) seconds, therefore, all proposed GPS Devices from new and existing accredited GPS Device Providers are required to submit their GPS Devices for re-inspection to ensure compatibility with the Board's new system (CPUVMS Central PUV Monitoring System).

WHEREAS, on 22 March 2021, the Information Systems Management Division has confirmed through e-mail that the herein applicant have successfully passed the GPS device testing conducted by the said Division.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, after finding the documents submitted to be complete and compliant, and for passing the necessary GPS testing procedures, this Committee hereby recommends to the Board to **GRANT** the renewal of accreditation of Inav Philippines Corporation as a GPS Device Provider.
