BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 084
Series of 2022

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 5(a) and (k) of Executive Order No. 202, Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) shall have the power to prescribe and regulate routes of service, economically viable capacities xxx, and to formulate, promulgate, administer, implement, and enforce rules and regulations on land transportation public utilities xxx;

WHEREAS, on 3 September 2012, the Board issued Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 2012-023, which was subsequently amended by Memorandum Circular No. 2012-026 dated 6 September 2012, requiring Public Utility Bus (PUB) operators to submit a duly notarized Schedule of Daily Trips for each of its authorized units;

WHEREAS, despite the issuance of MC 2012-026, there were reports that PUB operators failed to provide adequate public transportation services and to submit updated schedule of trips as required under the existing MC. More so, after validation of said reports and upon verification with the records, it was found that, indeed, PUB operators are not deploying all their authorized units;


WHEREAS, in order to properly monitor the trip schedule of all authorized PUB units, and to ensure adequate PUB service sufficient to cater to passenger demand, it is deemed proper and necessary to issue this Resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board resolves as it hereby resolved to reiterate the instruction under Memorandum Circular No. 2021-026, **DIRECTING** all PUB operators to submit a duly notarized Schedule of Daily Trips for each of its authorized routes directly to LTFRB office which has jurisdiction over its Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) **on or before 30 April 2022**.

The Trip Schedule should clearly indicate the time and day of dispatch for each of the unit, purposely for the proper monitoring and information of the riding public. Further, all scheduled trips shall be subject to the approval of the Board, and the same should be posted conspicuously within its designated premises inside the Integrated Terminal. Any change in the submitted schedule shall be subject to the approval of the Board.

Failure to submit the required schedule of trips and/or failure to comply with the approved schedule of trips shall be considered a violation of Memorandum Circular No. 2012-026, as such, the corresponding penalties provided in the said MC shall be applied and imposed.
