**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NUMBER 2022 - 037**

**SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2021-050 (re: ROUTE NAME AND STRUCTURE OF TACLOBAN CITY, LEYTE – GUIUAN, EASTERN SAMAR ROUTE)**

**WHEREAS**, on 09 August 2021, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2021-050, Re: OPENING OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF NEW CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE (CPC) UNDER THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE MODERNIZATION PROGRAM (PUVMP);

**WHEREAS**, pages 2 and 3 of the abovementioned Memorandum Circular indicated in item 4 of the first table the route structure of route TACLOBAN CITY, LEYTE – GUIUAN, EASTERN SAMAR, stated as:

Tacloban City Terminal, Leyte - Quezon Boulevard - Pan-Philippine Highway - Jct Taft-Oras-San Policarpio-Arteche Road - Balangiga, Eastern Samar - Jct Taft-Oras-San Policarpio-Arteche Road - Buenavista-Salcedo Road - Mercedes, Eastern Samar - Guiuan Terminal, Eastern Samar

**WHEREAS**, the information submitted and published regarding the detailed route structure on road names had caused confusion among Transport Service Entities (TSE) plying on the said route;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, pursuant to Section 5(a) of Executive Order No. 202, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board shall have the power “to prescribe and regulate routes of service, economically viable capacities and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles, the Board hereby **RENAMES** the route name from TACLOBAN CITY, LEYTE – GUIUAN, EASTERN SAMAR to TACLOBAN CITY, LEYTE – GUIUAN, EASTERN SAMAR via Southern Samar Coastal Road and vice versa; and, the detailed route structure to accurately show the towns and municipalities traversed by the route:
