RESOLUTION NO. 085 Series of 2022

(Re: Opening of Applications for the Issuance of New CPC for the route:
SM Angono - SM Aura under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-059)

WHEREAS, before this Committee are the applications of the following:

1. NEW OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE
2. ANGONO-BICUTAN TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE
3. RODRIGUEZ TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE
4. YELLOWDOT TRANSPORT TERMINAL INC.

for SM ANGONO - SM AURA route with the use of fifteen (15) authorized Class 2 PUJ units, under the initial selection/qualification process conducted on 12 November 2019;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that NEW OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE failed to submit/include in its qualification documents its undertaking that 25% of the number of required units within three (3) months, 50% within six (6) months, 100% within nine (9) months will be delivered but have attached two (2) undated letters, with "Undertaking" as its header, from Foton Pasig regarding (a) the same delivery schedule as the above-mentioned undertaking requirement, and (b) regarding the units being compliant with the specifications and standards under OFG and DTI-PNS wherein the two (2) documents should have been undertaken by the applicant and duly notarized; The applicant also submitted unnotarized document with "Undertaking" as its header, signed by its Chairman - Robert M. Noriega, regarding its compliance with the approved DOTr/LTPRP route rationalization study which also should have been undertaken by the applicant and duly notarized. As for the proposed garage/depot space, the applicant submitted a duly notarized contract of lease between the said applicant and Melven P. Bautista dated 1 August 2019 with attached photocopy of Transfer Certificate of Title numbered 722836 under the name of Melven P. Bautista which has a land area of 206sqm. In view of the above, it shows that the applicant failed to comply with the provisions set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that ANGONO-BICUTAN TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE failed to submit/include in its qualification documents its undertaking that the applicant will immediately comply with the approved DOTr/LPTRP route rationalization study, Fleet Management System with organized vehicle dispatch procedures, evidence of formal arrangement with Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) service provider that will offer inter-operable AFC service that is fully compliant with fare media related technical specifications, copies of letter of support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in both endpoints, manner of acquisition for the compliant PUV units identifying the funding source and with detailed financing plan and financial projections for the first five (5) years of operations, hence, the applicant's failure to comply with the provisions set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that RODRIGUEZ TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE were given a rating of “**PASSED/QUALIFIED**” as they have fully complied with the Qualification Requirements - Legal, Technical and Financial Capability requirements under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

WHEREAS, the Committee found that YELLOWDOT TRANSPORT TERMINAL INC. failed to submit/include in its qualification documents its letter of support from property owners/managers regarding access to, or use of, each off-street loading and unloading area in both endpoints, hence, the applicant’s failure to comply with the provisions set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Proclamation No. 922 entitled “Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency Throughout the Philippines” on 8 March 2020 relative to the alert of World Health Organization in December 2019 on the threat of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the Selection Process has been conducted for the new/developmental routes under the Memorandum Circular No. 2019-059 before the declaration of community quarantine in the Philippines on the onset of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, on 24 November 2021, the Board has issued its Resolution numbered 137 S. 2021 to proceed with all pending processes involving the Selection Process for the herein route;

WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 137 S. 2021 provides that:

“Accordingly, the use of interim units per MC 2019-013 shall no longer be applicable. Instead, OFG-Compliant units shall be required for selected entities.

Once an operator has been selected and issued a Notice of Selection, the corresponding Provisional Authority and QR Codes shall be subsequently issued after the submission of the required documents and subject to existing policies of the Board. No units shall be allowed to operate without the needed Provisional Authority and QR Codes.

All operators issued with NOS shall be given until June 30, 2022 to file their Application for Issuance of CPC with OFG compliant units. Failure to comply with the timeline shall automatically cause the revocation of the NOS and shall result in the commencement of new selection process for the route involved.

Applicant operators shall abide by the results of the Local Public Transport Route Plan or Route Rationalization studies.”

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, this Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to:

1. **DENY** the applications of NEW OPERATOR'S TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE, ANGONO-BICUTAN TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE and YELLOWDOT TRANSPORT TERMINAL INC. for failure to comply with the documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013. This is however without prejudice on their part to re-apply or submit application once the route is subsequently re-opened;

2. **AWARD** the SM ANGONO - SM AURA route in favor of RODRIGUEZ TRANSPORT SERVICE COOPERATIVE;
