**BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 101**  
**Series of 2022**

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Proclamation No. 922 entitled “Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency Throughout the Philippines” on 8 March 2020 in view of the reported COVID-19 cases in the country, which was later on extended until 12 September 2022 through Presidential Proclamation No. 1218;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Department Order No. 2017-011 or the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines, the year model of PUVs allowed to be accepted for new applications under the modernization program should be current as of franchise application;

**WHEREAS**, in the midst of this COVID-19 pandemic, the stakeholders, particularly PUV operators, have encountered challenges in complying with the components of the modernization program, especially, in the acquisition of OFG-compliant units;

**WHEREAS**, hearing from the clamor of the stakeholders, there are available/on-standby OFG-compliant units with year models 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 which were acquired by the stakeholders but were not yet applied and included in their application because of LPTRP and loan issues/concerns;

**WHEREAS**, treating the foregoing circumstances as not attributable to the PUV operators and manufacturers as those are beyond their control, the Board is prompted to be more lenient and considerable in the midst of this health and economic crisis;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board resolves as it hereby resolved to **APPROVE** and **ADOPT** the following guidelines:

1. Only brand-new Class 1, 2 and 3 OFG-compliant units with year model of 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 are allowed for acceptance under this Resolution;
2. The said units have been acquired by the operator in compliance with the PUV modernization program as shown by the Delivery Receipt and Sales Invoice, or the Official Receipt (OR) and Certificate of Registration (CR) of the units; and
3. The operator has a pending application for consolidation for new/developmental route with the LTFRB, and said units are primarily intended for the application and substitution of existing and not OFG-compliant units.
