RESOLUTION NO. 116 Series of 2022
(Re: Accreditation of Skyhawk Technology Systems, Inc.
as a GPS Device Provider)

WHEREAS, on 13 April 2022, the Chairman and Members of the Pre-Accreditation Committee issued a Resolution numbered 71 series of 2021 wherein the Committee resolved:

“**NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered, finding the documents submitted by Skyhawk Technology Systems, Inc. on 7 March 2022 to be incomplete due to its failure to submit/provide the above-mentioned documentary requirements set forth under Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 and 2016-016, this Committee resolves to **DIRECT** the herein applicant to **SUBMIT** to the Pre-Accreditation Committee of the same within the fifteen (15) working days from receipt of this resolution.”

WHEREAS, the documentary requirements which the applicant Skyhawk Technology Systems, Inc. needed to submit are the following:

1. 24/7 Nationwide Technical Support;

WHEREAS, on 29 April 2022, applicant Skyhawk Technology Systems, Inc. submitted its compliance to the above-mentioned resolution wherein an evaluation was thereafter conducted by the Committee and a recommendation was made on 6 May 2022;

WHEREAS, after careful and thorough evaluation of the above application and its supporting documents, the Pre-Accreditation Committee finds that the herein applicant is complete and compliant with Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 and 2016-016;

WHEREAS, on 25 November 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-078 which amends Item No. I-3 of Memorandum Circular No. 2015-013, which now prescribes that all GPS Devices must be able to send data to the server at least every ten (10) seconds, therefore, all proposed GPS Devices from new and existing accredited GPS Device Providers are required to submit their GPS Devices for re-inspection to ensure compatibility with the Board's new system (CPUVMS Central PUV Monitoring System).

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, finding the application of V3 Smart Technologies (Phil) Inc. to be complete and compliant with Memorandum Circular Nos. 2015-013 and 2016-016, this Committee hereby **DIRECTS** the herein applicant to **CONDUCT** the necessary GPS testing procedures with the Information Systems and Management Division which the latter shall issue a recommendation to this Committee pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2020-078.
