**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**  
**NUMBER 2022 - 050**

**SUBJECT: OPENING OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF NEW CERTIFICATES OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE (CPCs) UNDER THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE MODERNIZATION PROGRAM (PUVMP)**

**WHEREAS**, on 19 June 2017, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 2017 – 011, also known as, the Omnibus Guidelines on the Planning and Identification of the Public Road Transportation Services and Franchise Issuance adopting the rules and procedures for the issuance of the franchises for public transport routes and services;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 5(a) of Executive Order No. 202, dated 19 June 1987, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) shall have the power to “prescribe and regulate routes of service, economically viable capacities and zones or areas of operation of public land transportation services provided by motorized vehicles, xxx”;

**WHEREAS**, the DOTr has given LTFRB the authority to deliberate and take appropriate action on proposed new/additional routes pursuant to the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP) and Memorandum Circular No. 2018-006;

**WHEREAS**, the Central Office, Regional Franchising and Regulatory Offices of Regions 2, 3, 4-A, 7, 8, 9, and 11, National Project Management Office, and Regional Project Management Offices of Regions 2, 3, 4-A, 7, 8, 9, and 11, after their evaluation, recommended to the Board the additional units to Existing routes and the opening of New routes within their areas;

**NOW THEREFORE**, upon the recommendation of the PUVMP-PMO, Technical Division and Franchise Planning and Monitoring Division, this Board **APPROVES** the following routes with corresponding Route Survey Information for the issuance of New CPCs, to wit:

**\*PUBs shall have comfort rooms if the route distance is at least 100 kms.**

Only those units compliant with the OFG and DTI – PNS shall be accepted.

For the routes **Palompon, Leyte - Lemon Junction, Capoocan, Leyte and vice versa, Tacloban City, Leyte - Lemon Junction, Capoocan, Leyte via Tigbao, Leyte and vice versa, and Catbalogan City, Samar - Calbayog City, Samar and vice versa**, UVE may be allowed as the mode of service even if the routes exceeded the Maximum Distance Policy of 60 kilometers under Memorandum Circular No. 2017-031, also known as, “Implementing Rules on Maximum Distance Policy” under Department Order No. 2017-011, otherwise known as “Omnibus Franchising Guidelines”, in view of the **absence of a transfer area between the route ends** of the said routes.

For the routes **Pagadian City, Zamboanga Del Sur - Bayog, Zamboanga Del Sur via Lakewood, Zamboanga Del Sur and vice versa and Pagadian City, Zamboanga Del Sur - Tabina, Zamboanga Del Sur and vice versa**, UVE may be allowed as the mode of service even if the routes exceeded the Maximum Distance Policy of 60 kilometers under Memorandum Circular No. 2017-031, also known as “Implementing Rules on Maximum Distance Policy” under Department Order No. 2017-011, otherwise known as “Omnibus Franchising Guidelines”, in view of the **road conditions in the area that are not suitable for higher modes of transportation**.

For **EXISTING** routes, priority shall be given to consolidated entities that are currently plying the said route pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 2019-066, also known as, the *“Simplified Process for Applications for Consolidation of Individual and Existing Franchise Holders in Compliance with the PUVMP and the Department Order No. 2017-011 (OFG)”* dated 19 December 2019.

For NEW routes, the procedures in the selection of the operator under Section V-B of MC 2019-013 shall apply except Item No. 6 thereof. In which case, the provisions under MC 2021 - 021 Item I.A.1.v. regarding the compliance period of the compliant units, which shall be within the following period:

- 6 months - 25% of the total number of authorized units
- 9 months - 50% of the total number of authorized units
- 12 months - 100% of the total number of authorized units

*The Board shall issue a Certificate of Public Convenience to the applicant when the latter complies with the following required number of units:*

- *If the number of authorized units (NAU) is more than fifteen (15), the applicant shall have at least fifteen (15) OFG - compliant units;*
- *If the number of authorized units (NAU) is fifteen (15) or less, the applicant shall comply with all the NAU.*

Meanwhile, pending the issuance of CPC, the selected operator shall operate in an interim service within fifteen (15) days from receipt of the Notice of Selection using either its own units or units that are leased or chartered from other operators, manufacturers or dealers which must be roadworthy as determined by the Land Transportation Office (LTO). The corresponding Special Permit (for units with existing CPC) or Provisional Authority (for units without CPC) shall be issued, pursuant to the provisions of MC 2019-013.

A qualified Applicant may be selected for more than one (1) route and subsequently processed for the grant of CPC following the applicable provisions of Memorandum Circular No. 2019-013, also known as, the “Consolidated Guidelines on the Process of Issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC), and Provisional Authority (PA)/Special Permit (SP) under the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines & Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP)” dated 15 March 2019, and Memorandum Circular No. 2021-021, also known as, “Guidelines for the Issuance of Provisional Authority to Units of Individual Operators with Pending Application for Consolidation and those that Failed to File an Application for Consolidation Pursuant to the Omnibus Franchising Guidelines (OFG) and the Procedure in the Qualification and Selection of Applicants.”

In case of failure on the initial qualification process, **the Selection Committee shall issue a Resolution declaring the failure on the selection process**, with the corresponding date for the resubmission of the Letters of Intent and qualification documents by the interested applicants, which Resolution shall be posted or published in the Official website of the LTFRB (the Board Resolutions published online can be found under the Issuances button in the main page of the website).

Applicant operators shall abide by the results of the Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP) or Inter-Regional Inter-Provincial (IRIP) studies. The Regional Franchising and Regulatory Offices are directed to coordinate with the local government unit or third party consultant of LPTRP in order to include therein the route mentioned in this Memorandum Circular.



This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and the filing of three (3) copies hereof with the U.P. Law Center pursuant to Presidential Memorandum Circular No. 11 dated 09 October 1992.
