**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**

**SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR (MC) NO. 2022-046 re: ADDITIONAL ROUTES ALLOWED FOR THE OPERATION OF UV EXPRESS (UVE) ALONG COMMONWEALTH AVENUE DURING THE PERIOD OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN METRO MANILA AND ENTERING METRO MANILA**

**WHEREAS**, on 26 June 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular 2020-025 re: GUIDELINES FOR THE OPERATIONS OF UV EXPRESS DURING THE PERIOD OF GCQ IN METRO MANILA AND NEARBY PROVINCES ENTERING METRO MANILA

**WHEREAS**, on 21 October 2020, the Board issued Memorandum Circular 2020-062 re: ADDITIONAL ROUTES ALLOWED FOR THE OPERATION OF UV EXPRESS VEHICLES DURING THE PERIOD OF GCQ IN METRO MANILA AND ENTERING METRO MANILA;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the abovementioned circular, it mentioned that additional routes are allowed to operate during GCQ including the routes Deparo - SM North/C.I.T and Deparo - Central Integrated Terminal, with route code N27;

**WHEREAS**, on 09 February 2021, the Board issued Memorandum Circular 2021-006 re: ADDITIONAL ROUTES ALLOWED FOR THE OPERATION OF UV EXPRESS VEHICLES DURING THE PERIOD OF GCQ IN METRO MANILA AND ENTERING METRO MANILA;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the abovementioned circular, it mentioned that additional routes are allowed to operate during GCQ including the route Deparo - Cubao, with route code N56;

**WHEREAS**, Memorandum Circulars 2020-062 and 2021-006 specified in their respective annexes that the routes Deparo - SM North/C.I.T, Deparo - Central Integrated Terminal, and Deparo - Cubao, shall ply via Mindanao Avenue;

**WHEREAS**, on 04 April 2022, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2022-046 re: ADDITIONAL ROUTES ALLOWED FOR THE OPERATION OF UV EXPRESS (UVE) ALONG COMMONWEALTH AVENUE DURING THE PERIOD OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN METRO MANILA AND ENTERING METRO MANILA;

**WHEREAS**, in the Annex A of the abovementioned circular, it mentioned, that the routes Deparo - Cubao with route code N56 and Deparo - SM North/C.I.T and Deparo - Central Integrated Terminal with route code N27 are allowed to operate via Commonwealth Avenue during General Community Quarantine;

**WHEREAS**, upon review by the technical team, it appears that the original pre-COVID route structure of the abovementioned routes were via Mindanao Avenue and not Commonwealth Avenue;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for the consistent application of the routes' pre-COVID route structure, the Board hereby **AMENDS** the following, to wit:


