BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 130
Series of 2022

WHEREAS, on 12 April 2022, the Board issued a Board Resolution No. 065 RE:Lifting the moratorium for the issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience to operate Transport Network Vehicle Service (TNVS) for additional Seven Thousand TNVS units/slots for Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, the Technical Division (TD) submitted a report (Re: Report on the First day of TNVS application) dated 4 May 2022. Out of the two hundred (200) applications that were scheduled to be accepted, only thirty-two (32) applications were successfully received for processing;

WHEREAS, the Legal Division and Technical Division verified the Certificate of Conformity attached to the applications received and out of seven (7) Certificates verified, five (5) were found to be fake and spurious;

WHEREAS, this Board received a report that in order for the applicant to comply with the initial requirement for the filing of the application, fake/spurious Certificate of Registration is now being used to circumvent the filing of certificate of Conformity by removing the annotation that the unit is encumbered;

WHEREAS, considering the initial result of the verification made to the Certificate of Conformity and to further ascertain the genuineness and authenticity of the documents attached to the applications accepted, the Legal Division tried to verify the Certificates of Conformity to various banks. However, due to the confidentiality of the nature of the said documents, the authority of the person designated to do the verification is required by some banks to entertain the request;

WHEREAS, random checking by Technical Division and Legal Division on the submitted Certificate of Registration issued by the Land Transportation Office (LTO) on vehicles subject of TNVS applications has also resulted in some tampered or spurious registrations particularly in making the unit appear unencumbered;

WHEREAS, that during the submission of the formal offer of evidence, there are some Certificates of Registration being offered as part of the evidence, which has an apparent difference or discrepancies from regularly submitted certificate of registration;

WHEREAS, in view of the initial findings of submitted fake or spurious documents by TNVS applicants, there is a need to formalize request for verification with the LTO and private banks/financing companies on the authenticity of the documents submitted by the applicants;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board, hereby resolves as it is hereby **RESOLVED** that **Atty. ZONA RUSSET M. TAMAYO** and **JOEL J. BOLANO** be authorized to sign, verify and perform any and all other acts necessary on behalf of the Land

Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board, all documents pertaining the application for TNVS including, but not limited to, Certificate of Conformity and Certificate of Registration.
