**RESOLUTION NO. 143 Series of 2022**

(re: Application for Accreditation of THAUMAZO EXPRESS  
TRANSPORT SOLUTIONS as Transportation Network Company)

**WHEREAS**, relative to the issued Memorandum Circular No. 2021-066, lifting the moratorium in the acceptance of Application for Accreditation of Transport Network Company (TNC), herein Applicant, Thaumazo Express Transport Solutions submitted its Application to the Pre-Accreditation Committee (PAC) on 21 April 2022;

**WHEREAS**, on 26 May 2022, the members of the PAC convened in a meeting, there having a quorum, they proceeded with the evaluation and deliberation of the Application submitted by Thaumazo Express Transport Solutions;

**WHEREAS**, after careful examination of the documents submitted, the PAC found that Thaumazo Express Transport Solutions **failed** to submit the following documentary requirements, as well as the other significant remarks found on the submitted documents, to wit:

1. Certificate of Registration of Incorporation/Partnership issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and Articles of Incorporation/Partnership with primary purpose as Transport Network Company or Transportation;
2. Proof of Financial Capability to Sustain the Operation of TNC and to Pay all Judgements and Awards that may be rendered for any cause arising out of the operation as TNC:
  - a. Proof of Bank Deposit (except time deposit) with at least Five Million pesos (Php 5,000,000.00);
  - b. Audited Financial Statements by an Independent Auditor;
3. Secretary's Certificate of the Board/Partnership Resolution authorizing the representative to sign the Application for Accreditation for and in behalf of the corporation;
4. Secretary's Certificate of Incumbent Corporate/Partnership Officers and List of Directors/Partners;
5. Complete Description of Business Model;
6. Established physical office with Monitoring Facility capable of generating daily report relative to the operation of their accredited TNVS/Taxis, such as but not limited to active TNVS/Taxis, bookings and ridership;
7. Business Permit duly issued by the local government where the applicant's principal place of business is located, related to public transportation;
8. Process of Accrediting/Affiliating vehicles Transportation Network Vehicle Service (TNVS)/Taxi vehicle;
9. Process of Accrediting/Affiliating TNVS/Taxi Drivers;
10. Terms of Service for Passengers;
11. Terms of Service for TNVS Operators;
12. Marketing Plan/Strategy to promote its brand;
13. Proposal Fare Rates and/or Service Charges;
14. Proposal for the Establishment of a Drivers' Training Program only for TNCs utilizing TNVS units;

15. Undertaking to comply with the Terms and Conditions for a Certificate of TNC Accreditation;
16. Complaint Mechanism facility capable of generating monthly report to be submitted to the Board relative to complaints/reports against accredited TNVS vehicle and driver, indicating the actions taken and recent status of the complaint;
17. Sufficient number of employees, including IT personnel with their names, necessary to assume the responsibility as TNC.

**WHEREAS**, taking into consideration the role of TNCs in the operation of Transport Network Vehicle Services in the country, Applicants must fully comply and satisfy all the requirements of the MC No. 2021-066, to warrant the issuance of a Certificate of Accreditation;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the PAC hereby recommends to the Board to **DENY** herein Applicant, Thaumazo Express Transport Solutions its Certificate of Accreditation as a Transport Network Company (TNC) for its failure to comply with the provisions set forth under Memorandum Circular No. 2021-066. This is however without prejudice on the applicant's part to re-apply or submit its application for accreditation.


