**Board Resolution No. 145**  
**Series of 2022**

**WHEREAS**, on 28 April 2022, the Board issued Memorandum Circular No. 2022-050 Re: Opening of Applications for Issuance of New Certificates of Public Convenience (CPCs) under the Implementation of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP);

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to said Circular, the following existing routes were opened for additional units as recommended by the Regional Franchising Regulatory Office 11 (RFRO No. 11) and PUVMP Regional Project Management Office No. 11 (PUVMP-RPMO No. 11):

**WHEREAS**, for existing routes, MC 2019-066 Section V.1 provides:

*“Should there be a need for any additional units on an existing route as a result of the LPTRP or DOTr Route Rationalization Study, the consolidated operator shall be given priority to increase their number of authorized units to meet the demand. If the consolidated operator fails to meet said additional demand in their given route after the period as the Board may subsequently determine but in no case more than six (6) months, new entrants may be entertained. The selection of the new operator shall be based on the procedures as prescribed under Section V-B of Memorandum Circular 2019-013”.*

**WHEREAS**, the existing operator of the aforesaid routes, Mallen Transport and Gasoline Station, Inc., submitted its qualification documents on 06 June 2022;

**WHEREAS**, on the same day of 06 June 2022, the Qualification Committee of RFRO No. 11 conducted the selection proceedings, and subsequently issued Resolution No. 55 Series of 2022 and Resolution No. 56 Series of 2022 denying the application of the existing operator, Mallen Transport and Gasoline Station Inc., for the routes Davao City - Boston, Davao Oriental via Compostela and Davao City - Banganga, Davao Oriental via Compostela respectively due to its failure to submit the complete qualification documents;

**WHEREAS**, on 13 June 2022, Mallen Transport and Gasoline Station Inc. informed RFRO No. 11 through a letter that they do not have the capacity to provide the authorized additional units as stated in the MC;

**WHEREAS**, on 20 June 2022, Mallen Transport and Gasoline Station Inc. submitted a Waiver of Rights and Interest to RFRO No. 11 formally waiving its preferential right to supply the additional units on the said route;

**WHEREAS**, considering that the existing operator, Mallen Transport and Gasoline Station, Inc. has expressly signified that it cannot supply the authorized additional number of units, and waived its right on the routes, the same should now be offered and opened to new qualified entrants;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board **RESOLVES** as it hereby **RESOLVED** to open the following routes to other interested applicants for Selection Process:

Section V.B of MC No. 2019-013 and the applicable provision of MC No. 2022-050 shall govern the guidelines in the conduct of the selection process. Only those units compliant with the OFG and DTI-PNS shall be accepted.
