

RESOLUTION NO. 099 Series of 2019
(Re: PRE QUALIFICATION OF
PREMIUM POINT TO POINT SERVICE)

WHEREAS, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) issued a Memorandum Circular No. 2019-010 (Re: Implementing Guidelines on the Opening of Proposed Additional Premium Point to Point Bus Service) dated March 5, 2019.

WHEREAS, the Board has created a Pre Qualification Committee for the Accreditation of Premium Point to Point Bus Service;

WHEREAS, on 10 April 2019, the Pre Qualification Committee opened the sealed envelopes/boxes submitted by the applicants for additional PREMIUM POINT-TO-POINT SERVICES IN **PACKAGE 15** for the route : **(a) LIPA, BATANGAS-ALABANG; (b) LIPA, BATANGAS-LAWTON** with the total units of fifty nine (55), the following prospective applicants for Premium Point to Point Service submitted their respective Qualification Documents:

- 1) CERES TRANSPORT INC.; and
- 2) DLTB CO.

WHEREAS, during the opening of the said package, the Committee ruled not to open the documents submitted by CERES TRANSPORT INC., pending the outcome of the investigation regarding the manifestation filed by Atty. Alexander Versoza. Upon investigation of the Qualification Committee (per Board directive), the documents submitted by Ceres Transport, Inc. during the date of submission were contained in sealed envelopes while the documents presented during the opening of documents were already contained in sealed boxes without the markings set forth by the Selection Committee (i.e, stamp received and numbering);

WHEREAS, Applicant **DLTB CO.** was given by the Committee a "FAILED" rating for failing to comply with the Technical Qualification requirement by not submitting the following documents: 1) Undertaking to have a compliant garage with zoning clearance immediately upon availability of compliant PUV units, in case the Applicant is selected;

NOW THEREFORE, the Pre Qualification Committee resolves to recommend to the Board to **RE-OPEN** to prospective applicants **PACKAGE 15 (a) LIPA, BATANGAS-ALABANG; (b) LIPA, BATANGAS-LAWTON** of the PREMIUM POINT TO POINT SERVICE under MC 2019-010
