



MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 88-023

SUBJECT : Applications for Certificates of Public Convenience to operate SHUTTLE bus services

In view of the absence of a definition of a shuttle bus service and/or criteria for determining what the said type of service consists of, for purposes of accepting for filing, processing and hearing applications denominated as applications for shuttle bus services, the Board will disregard the nomenclature given the applications but will determine the real nature of the proposed service with the following as guidelines:

1. the extent of the proposed service, whether it caters to a fixed and limited clientele or is available for general patronage to the riding public;
2. the number of units proposed for operation;
3. the schedule of operation of the units;
4. the existence of a contract between the operator and patrons; and
5. the absence or availability of regular transportation between the two points covered by the proposed shuttle service.

This memorandum circular is prospective in nature and will not apply to applications already granted by the present Board's predecessors. However, existing certificates of public convenience for the operation of shuttle services shall be covered by policies, guidelines, rules and regulations that may hereafter be issued by the Board pursuant to and in accordance with its powers and functions under Executive Order No. 202.
