**SUBJECT : AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NO. 95-009 (PENALTY FOR LATE FILING OF
APPLICATIONS/PETITIONS)**

Memorandum Circular No. 95-009 was issued by the Board on August 25, 1995 to address the problem of late filing of applications/petitions for extension of validity of expiring/expired CPC's, and other related pleadings where a reglementary period is prescribed.

Under the said memorandum circular, an extension of six (6) months was allowed applicants/petitioners who failed to file their applications/petitions for extension of validity including pleadings where there is a prescribed reglementary period.

Despite the said extension of six (6) months from the dates of expiry of their CPC's within which to file their applications/petitions for extension of validity, there are CPC holders for the operation of jeepney services, who for meritorious reasons, were not able to file their applications/petitions with the Board. These CPC holders are mostly small jeepney operators with authorized units under their expired CPC's ranging from one(1) to five (5) units on the operation of which units their livelihood depends.

To enable these marginalized small jeepney operators to extend the validity of their expired CPC's, the Board has resolved to further extend the period within which these small operators with authorized units ranging from one (1) to five (5) units may file their applications for extension of validity and other related petitions necessary for the operation of their authorized services, for an extended period, ending December 31, 1996.

Memorandum Circular No. 95-009 is hereby amended to allow operators of jeepney services with authorized units ranging from one (1) to five (5) units to file their applications/petitions for extension of validity of their expired CPC's and related petitions necessary for the registration and operation of their units up to

December 31, 1996 provided the prescribed penalties are paid. It is hereby categorically stated that no further extension will be allowed by this Board.

This amendatory Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.
