Subject : NEW APPLICATIONS FOR PROVINCIAL PUB  
ROUTES ENTERING METRO MANILA

Pursuant to the Board's Memorandum Circular Nos. 95-013 and 97-009 a moratorium in the acceptance, processing and resolution of PUB applications on provincial routes entering Metro Manila was enforced for the reasons therein stated.


To determine which routes may be opened for PUB applications to meet the increased demand for additional buses, a survey of major routes was undertaken by the DOTC-formed Technical Working Group with the involvement of the existing franchised bus operators on and along said routes.

The findings and results of the said surveys show that certain identified provincial bus routes entering Metro Manila may be opened to CPC applications to meet increased passenger demand on said routes and to fill-up the vacuum created by the cessation of operation of certain bus firms/operators, completely or partially, on these routes.


The lines that will be opened for application will be announced by the Board on June 1, 2000 by posting said lists in conspicuous places in the LTFRB premises and in announcements in newspapers of general circulation.

In the meantime, the Board will be completing its inventory of all pending PUB applications on the said routes and will be finalizing the necessary guidelines/criteria/procedures for the acceptance, processing and grant of the applications on the subject routes.
